AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Each Competitor (This includes at least one recorded owner and all Trainers, Drivers, Riders, Halter Handlers, Coaches, and the person(s) signing the entry blank), in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership/Competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per Competitor

When an Agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized Competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership.

Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Walk-Trot Classes are exempt from AHA Membership Requirements at Qualifying Competitions but must have an AHA Membership with Competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Lead Line Classes or Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership Requirements. (BOD 5/12)

GENERAL RULES:

1. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association, Equestrian Canada, New Hope Ranch, Saskatchewan Arabian Horse Association, WSDAC, its officers, contract personnel or volunteers or any of its affiliates, will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury, to any exhibitor, his or her agent or employee, or to any horse or any article of any kind. The exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury, to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify all parties above against any land loss, damages, or liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Entry Secretary shall constitute and acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
2. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any official or volunteer of the New Hope Ranch AHA Value Show on the part of any owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler may result in the immediate removal from the show of said person, at the discretion of the show committee and the owner will forfeit their entry fees. Such action will be reported to EC and AHA disciplinary action. Official protest (\$100.00 cash fee) will be filed as per the EC Rule Book A1206.
3. The Show Committee reserves itself the power to remove any person or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make necessary alterations in the prize list program.
5. Patterns and Order of Go will be posted at least one hour prior to the class.
6. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any class with less than 3 horses entered.
7. Stallions MAY NOT be shown in WALK/TROT/JOG classes. If at any time the Show Committee, Judge, feel that a stallion is uncontrollable, that animal will be removed.
8. The number of horses calculated as competing is at the closing of the gate and the beginning of the class for all classes shown as a group and all those who pass through the gate in individual activity.
9. Awards: Regular Classes: Ribbons to 5th and Placings to 6th place.
10. Competition Numbers must always be worn and visible when the horse is out of their stall.

Barn Calls and Gate Holds

1. Barn Calls are a courtesy only. Exhibitors must ascertain when classes are being judged. Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the Hitching Ring attendant before each respective class is called for showing and must enter the ring promptly when called. Two Minute Gates: In collective classes, the gate will close two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring, or in large classes taking more than two minutes the gate will be closed at the completion of the final horse in a continuous string of horses entering the ring. After the gate is closed, no entry will be allowed in unless approved by the Judge. No Exceptions. EC B1306.8 In single event classes, such as reining, the gate will close within one (1) minute of that individual rider being called to the ring in the order that is posted on the Order of Go.
2. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. (A602.2)
3. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location. (A602.5)
4. Per Article A801, every entry at an AHA Recognized Show and/or EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. (A602.7)
5. NO Hors concours
6. Substitution of horse and/or rider will be allowed, and request must be filed with the show office.
7. Cancellations: Competitors cancelling after the official closing gate will be refunded entry minus administration fee of \$ 25.00 upon receipt of a vet certificate of disability or a doctor's certificate
8. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR Approved Protective headgear (See Glossary, Headgear Standards). NOTICE – **ARTICLE A905 HEADGEAR 1. At all times, persons mounted or carriage driving at an EC sanctioned event location must wear approved protective headgear as described below. Exceptions: See discipline or breed sport rules: a) Section B – Arabian: B1306.7, B1501.22, B1602.3, B1702.3, B1802.3, B1902.5, B2002.4, B2402.4, B2402.6, B2403.3, B2610.3, B3002.9, B3604.5, B3605.2, B3605.5, B3606.2 B3611.2. B3701.4, 2. Protective headgear must be: a) approved by an accredited certification organization. See Glossary – Headgear Standards; b) properly

fitted; and securely fastened by a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet. 3. Any competitor may wear approved protective headgear in any division or class without a penalty from the judge. 4. EC makes no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any approved protective headgear. EC cautions riders and drivers that serious injury or death may result despite wearing such headgear, as all equestrian sports involve inherent risk, and no protective headgear can protect against all foreseeable injury. All Breed Specifications: All Breed Classes and All Breed Equitation Classes will be conducted according to EC Section F General Performance All Breed Showmanship will be conducted according to EC Section F Chapter

“AHA Value Shows only count toward AHA qualifications and programs.

JUNIOR - An individual who has not reached his or her 19th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition (See AHA Rule Book)”

****TBA classes are offered for purchase at this shows and will be “sold” on a first come first serve basis Any class on the AHA Class List, or that is recognized by AHA, in the Sport Horse in Hand, Sport Horse Under Saddle, Dressage: Intro through 4th level, Western Dressage: Intro through Level 4 are available as a TBA class. All other sections are excluded.**

The TBA fee will be charged to the exhibitor requesting the class plus the class fee, all other entrants will pay only the class entry fee. “

The Show Committee reserves the right to approve the class proposed for purchase.

Exhibitors are welcome to bring their own pens or tie to their trailer.

Cancellation of Entry: Exhibitors canceling entries after the closing date of May 20, 2024, will forfeit ALL fees.

Refunds will be considered upon receipt of a suitable veterinarian certificate attesting to the illness or injury received by the show secretary. All granted refunds will be sent out by mail after the close of the show and will be made payable to the owner of the horse. Vet Outs will be refunded the AHA Resolution 9/90 fee as per AHA rules. A Vet out processing fee of \$25.00 per horse plus the office fee will be retained on all refunded entries

AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association® (AHA®) Handbook and the Value Show Rules and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules **and understand all decisions made by the judge are deemed final and can not be protested.**

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites, or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to **release** AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and **all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent** permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition **INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES**, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, Equestrian Canada or U.S. Equestrian Federation permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, **I agree to accept AS FINAL** the decision of the particular hearing body. **I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue** AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered .

I FUTHER AGREE that by participating in an Amateur class that I am in compliance with the USEF /EC Amateur rule.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain in effect.

Do Not Move the Patient

1. Notify the Show office by telephone or radio, who will then notify medical personnel & Show Management

2. Catch the horse (if applicable).

Medical personnel will evaluate the patient & determine status.

3. Advise the show office by Radio - Show office will call 911.

Exhibitors are asked **NOT** to use their cell phones as the area code affects the directions.

4. Announcer will ask exhibitors to clear the area, then the Ringmaster, Steward or Show Management will help keep spectators back.

5. Show Personnel will keep the road clear so ambulance can get through without hurting anyone else.

6. A member of Show Personnel should be at the front entrance to meet the ambulance Ask them to turn off their siren and escort them to the scene of the accident.

(Ambulance sirens could spook a horse and cause additional accidents)
