

Test of Choice: walk/walk, Intro A, B, C, D, Basic A, B, C, D, Level 1 A, B, C, D Level 2 A, B, C, , Level 3 A,B,C,D

Six divisions- (can only choose one) Pee Wee (under 12), Junior (12-18), Adult Amatuer, Senior Amatuer (over 50), Pro, Gaited. Age is as of January 1, 2022.

Class Fee: \$25/test

Office Fee: \$15/ Horse and Rider Combo

Non Member Fee: \$15

### **General Information:**

1. Must be an [SMWSD](#) member, or pay a non-member fee. [SMWSD](#) member scores will count towards year end awards. If you wish to have your scores count towards WSDAC points you must have a WSDAC number, and your horse needs to be registered through WSDAC.
2. Walk/walk, Intro and Basic test must be ridden in a 20m x 40m ring. Level 1 and up must be ridden in a 20m x60m ring. Use an arena that is as close as possible to regulation size with letters spaced accordingly where the judge can see.  
**Helmets are strongly recommended and mandatory for Pee Wee and Junior.**
3. All entries are to be sent to [smwsd.members@gmail.com](mailto:smwsd.members@gmail.com) if you cannot use the jotform send all the information and we will fill it out for you. Payment by e-transfer preferred, however we will take cheques. Entry will be considered complete when entry and payment are both received.
4. Judge will send photocopies of the scored test to your cell phone number provided.

### **Video Submission:**

1. Videos must be uploaded to your own Youtube account and sent to the Show Secretary; only one video per test. **Two judges may not judge the same test.**
2. Full video instructions to be found at [www.westernstyledressage.ca](http://www.westernstyledressage.ca) in the Rulebook 16.04, page 53-55. **Please read them over.**
3. Tests must be videoed from C in a **LANDSCAPE** video orientation.
4. Videos of tests must be **UNEDITED** from start to finish. They must be **one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible the entire duration**. Make sure ring letters are in frame. You may zoom in on far corners, try to keep full horse and rider in frame on near corners.
5. Tests may be called. Sounds must be on, natural background noise audible.
6. Prior to the test being ridden a sign must be shown clearly stating riders name, name of the show, date of the show, horses name, and test being ridden.
7. At the end of the ride a tack check must be recorded. Each side of the horse must be shown, either with the camera walking around or the horse turning (5 seconds each side) . The rider will then dismount to drop the bit.
8. Upload the video to Youtube and email the link to [smwsd.members@gmail.com](mailto:smwsd.members@gmail.com) with your name and the test in the subject.
