PURPOSE
<p>The musical freestyle performance should clearly show the unity between rider and horse as well as harmony in all the movements and transitions.</p> <p>In addition to the requirements of the Introductory Level, the horse at Basic Level has developed increased balance and activity of the hindquarters to achieve improved connection and softness with the rider.</p> <p>All jog work may be ridden sitting or rising unless stated.</p> <p>Halts may be through the walk.</p>

ARENA SIZE & RIDE TIME
<p>ARENA SIZE: Small (20x40)</p> <p>RIDE TIME: Maximum time allowed 4:00 <i>(Time begins when the horse moves forward after the competitor's halt and salute, and ends with the final halt and salute)</i></p>

All figures (regardless of size), patterns, combinations or transitions composed of elements permitted in the declared level are permitted, even if the resulting configuration is found only in higher levels.	If a compulsory movement has been left out (no execution can be seen), the movement must be marked with a zero. The mark for choreography will be negatively influenced and the mark for degree of difficulty cannot be higher than 5.
