PURPOSE

The musical freestyle performance should clearly show the unity between rider and horse as well as harmony in all the movements and transitions. In addition to the requirements of the Level 1, the horse at Level 2 now demonstrates

In addition to the requirements of the Level 1, the horse at Level 2 now demonstrates increased engagement, especially in the lengthened jog and lope. Transitions between collected, and lengthened gaits should be well defined. The horse should show a greater degree of straightness, bending, suppleness, throughness, balance and self-carriage than at Level 1.

ARENA SIZE & RIDE TIME

ARENA SIZE: Standard (20x60)

RIDE TIME: Maximum time allowed 6:00 (Time begins when the horse moves forward after the competitor's halt and salute, and ends with the final halt and salute)
