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PURPOSE

The musical freestyle performance should clearly show the unity between rider and horse as well as harmony in all the movements and transitions. In addition to the requirements of Level 3, the horse at Level 4 now maintains a higher

In addition to the requirements of Level 3, the horse at Level 4 now maintains a higher degree of connection and collection. The horse remains light and balanced performing the movements required with an emphasis on imperceptibility, accuracy and finesse than at Level 3.

ARENA SIZE & RIDE TIME

ARENA SIZE: Standard (20x60)

RIDE TIME: Maximum time allowed 6:30 (Time begins when the horse moves forward after the competitor's halt and salute, and ends with the final halt and salute)
