And restaurants from coast to coast are seeing demand skyrocket: Food & Wine reports that non-alcoholic beverage sales at the Four Seasons Philadelphia doubled in just five months after launching a dedicated menu. Mocktail Fest Miami gives brands a chance to meet both consumers and trade in a dynamic and rapidly expanding market.

"Mocktail Fest Miami isn't just an event, it's part of a lifestyle shift," said Marlene Aguilar, Co-Founder. "People are embracing conscious living, and this festival connects them to the best alternative beverages and ideas shaping that movement."

The city's evolution provides a powerful backdrop. As reported this summer in Miami Today News outlet, Miami Beach has embraced the <u>Blue Zones initiative</u>, reorienting its identity toward wellness, healthier lifestyles, and mindful community programming. "We
