The Great Deception – Part 3

As we enter the committee rooms of the gentlemen appointed to giving us the Revised Version, we need to remember that there was meant to be a noble task before them. The reality was however, that there were individuals who were there to destroy the great labours of a past generation. Westcott and Hort had the lead in this task but there were others who have been previously mentioned who were there with no good intent. Even today, we need to be aware that in translation committees there can be found unbelievers, apostates, liberals and those who corrupt God's Word. Many believers are relying on their 'scholarship'. Often well known Christian personalities will let their names be attached to the sale of a new 'bible' who have done no work on its production themselves. I am not bothered what 'big name' endorses it, I want to know what manuscripts it's based on. That of course is not likely to be difficult.

Before we move on again with our two infamous gentlemen, Westcott and Hort, I am reminded of something a brother wrote (who is with the Lord now), in reference to these 'more accurate' bibles, 'Why has no one ever produced an inerrant translation in 380 years if they knew the errors contained in the A.V/KJV?''They are still 'working at it', but still confessing they cannot produce a perfect translation. Why not, if they know where the imperfections were in the previous ones? Do you mean to tell me that 3000 plus saved men, with all the 'best and oldest manuscripts' and 'Dead Sea Scrolls' and 'better knowledge of Hebrew and Greek', all working

together, cannot produce an inerrant Bible? WHY NOT? THEY WERE THE ONES WHO PROFESSED TO HAVE ENOUGH KNOWLEDGE TO FIND ERRORS IN THE ONE GOD GAVE THEM. Surely, if they can spot an error, they can correct it, can't they? They made more than 35000 corrections in the A.V without perfecting it?and the CORRECTIONS HAVE NOT ALL BEEN MADE YET?....'These are the 'experts' - the men who profess to be able to correct the Holy Bible....After 380 years of labour they cannot correct it; all they did was alter words, swap verses, omit and add readings and produce what they profess is NOT an inerrant Bible'.




As we sit down with the revisers let us remind ourselves of their brief, they were to make changes in spelling and the updating of certain words. They were to do only that which was necessary. The idea of a unique position being given to the Vatican manuscript and behind it some 'primitive archetype', ie text to be conjectured, not one in existence; and then that two manuscripts take priority over all other evidence was insane. The Revised Version is based on a corrupted text, as one critic has said, 'the foulest and most vicious in existence'. This is not a matter of the distant past, it's ramifications apply now in 2021. All versions of the Bible published since the times of Westcott and Hort are throw-backs of antiquity which were known to be corrupted at the time of the Reformation. Modern bibles are based on corrupt texts which were dumped by the Early Church in the fourth century A.D. The A.V translators used a text that is older than the best manuscripts used by Westcott and Hort.

Hort regarded the manuscripts most reliable which were readings backed by Origen, these readings were almost certainly those which in the third century were the preferred ones at

Alexandria. Hort majors on the use of the Alexandrian text. Indeed, Westcott and Hort claim they restored the text of Origen, and, that which is represented by the Vaticanus is 'neutral' and sound as opposed to all others. This is incredible, their 'selected readings' are no proof of that. Further, Origen is as reliable as a leaky bath-tub. He is often mystical in interpretations and has no serious command of Hebrew. He is speculative and one should never adopt any conclusion, any reading, which vests in his authority. Bishop Marsh said, 'Whenever therefore grammatical interpretation produced a sense which in Origen's opinion was irrational or impossible according to the philosophy which Origen had learnt at Alexandria, he then departed from the literal sense'. Origen is utterly unreliable in textual matters. Alexandria was a hot-bed of heresy, no way was God's Word going to be kept pure there. The manuscripts Aleph and B have clearly been tampered with and revised.

Vaticanus or B is not a 'neutral text'. The maligned Textus Receptus served in large measure as the base which B tampered with and corrupted, the Church knew this before 1881. Westcott and Hort's work is a LIE from start to finish. Anyone who has looked at all the evidence (and understood it), can only agree with their arguments by being wilfully blind. They should never have been allowed near a revision work. Their 'labours' for the Church destroyed the faith of many in the Received Text.



The majority of the manuscripts have a Greek Text which closely resembles the basis of our A.V/KJV. Many believers are led to believe by countless ministers, (and certain rubbish books), that the A.V is supported by inferior manuscripts, what they don't realise is that certain critics have called inferior manuscripts those that make up the majority that support the A.V.

Westcott and Hort were denying to the Majority Text any claim to represent the actual form of the Original. They had decided that the mysterious Vaticanus was to have position over everything. While textual criticism was and is rejecting any claim of the Majority Text to represent the Original, they are still unable to explain its rise, it's comparative uniformity, and it's dominance in a way that satisfies. The point is, these factors can be accounted for, if the Majority Text is representative of a continuous transmission of the Original.

Of course Westcott and Hort and their modern day disciples don't like this. However, when we look at the ancient records of the manuscript tradition of an old book, they usually multiply in a regular fashion. The result of this is that the copies nearest the original will normally be the most in number. The Majority Text, on which the A.V/KJV is based, has the best claim by far to be regarded as an authentic representative of the Original. Further, this point in independent of scholarly conjectures about 'readings' etc, because it is based on the objective reality of its dominance in the history of transmission of the New Testament Text. This dominance has not and cannot, (we believe), be explained. Certainly New Testament textual criticism has given no objectively verifiable reason to reject the A.V/KJV.

The view popularised by Westcott and Hort that the Majority Text came from an ecclesiastical revision as long gone in the waste basket. Later scholars like Geerlings and Colwell were in agreement that a supposed revision was the work of the imagination. The great scholar Dean Burgon B.A, M.A, B.D who was a contemporary of Westcott and Hort, (and who we have yet to meet), scoffed at the revision idea.

When these various sandcastles started to get washed away, the critics resorted to evolutionary process over time. Ah yes, TIME, the answer to every problem when scholars ran out of sense. However, the Majority Text is quite uniform in character with low amounts of variation between its major representatives. No one has sensibly explained, how a long slow process (evolution), that was (supposedly) over centuries as well as

covering a wide geographical area, plus a large amount of copyists who probably knew nothing g of the state of the text outside of where they lived, were able to achieve a widespread uniformity out of the diversity presented by the earlier forms of the text.

Dean Burgon appealed to the realisation that the New Testament is the Word of God and therefore must be handled differently to other documents. He states, 'The Holy Scriptures are not an arena for the exercise or display of the ingenuity of critics'. Hort's conclusions time after time are entirely subjective, often seen in his use of phrases like, 'if such there be', Darwin in his writings uses nebulous terms. Westcott and Hort rely on the argument from silence and it is a silence that kills their theory DEAD. As Dr Scrivener said, 'Dr Hort's system, therefore, is entirely destitute of historical foundation'.

One thing is for sure, Vaticanus and the Majority Text cannot both be right. Think for a moment, if the Majority Text is say at least as old as Vaticanus, (and Hort admits that), why is the authority of Vaticanus, (one manuscript), to take precedence over a huge amount of manuscripts, versions, lexionaries and Church Fathers which support the Majority Text.

We are very aware that the Westcott and Hort theory has dominated the field of New Testament textual criticism for a long time now, (like Darwin's theory has in science), however, there were hugely learned men at that time who rejected it, (as with Darwinism) the modern student, (if they even know), might think the theory sacrosanct. Again, like Darwin's theory students think it irrefutable.

To defend the A.V today is to be labelled either a fool or a bigot. That silences most preachers for a start. Well, this is about the Truth of God's Word, not honours, position, acceptability, praise etc. I am warning you, whoever or whatever you are in the Church, that modern bibles are corrupt.

Well, let's close with a little test (homework), take out your modern bible and see if it has three important verses.

- 2. 1 Tim 6v20
- 3. 2 Cor 2v17

Not there? Of course if you don't have an A.V. you may not know what they say. You better find out. Don't allow 'scholars' to steal your inheritance in Christ.

The Poor Man's Earl

At this time of year we marvel (although this should be a constant state of heart for all believers) at how Our Lord Jesus set aside His glory and majesty for a season. This He did so that He might take on flesh and blood of man, becoming the last Adam, fulfilling a sinless life that the first Adam failed to do thus bringing sin into all Creation. Then He offered this sinless life as a perfect offering for the sins of man, so that

those who believed on Him might be gifted eternal life through His eternal righteousness.

This staggering act of the King of Kings putting aside His worthy glory for the good of such poor, pitiful souls as we, was wonderfully reflected in the life of the 6th Earl of Shaftesbury in the 19th century. Born Anthony Ashley Cooper in 1801, this young boy, though enjoying all the comforts of aristocratic life, he was passed off by his parents into the care of the house keeper, Maria Mills. Under her attentive care, young Anthony was taught the power and beauty of the Bible, faith in Christ and earnest prayer. Through this devoted tutelage from Miss Mills, Anthony became a committed Christian in his teenage years. This solid foundation in the saving grace of Jesus Christ served him well in the next forty years of his life as he became a civic leader and Member of Parliament, along with being an active evangelist within the Anglican Church.

Lord Shaftesbury (our once young Anthony) became deeply concerned about the terrible working conditions of young boys in England who were used as chimney sweeps for the large Victorian chimneys of the era. These young lads would be sent to climb up inside the soot encrusted chimneys to clean from within. The foul air they breathed in caused many deadly illnesses in the boys and some young lads would get stuck inside the tight chimneys and die a tragic, lonely death.

Lord Shaftesbury pushed through a parliamentary Bill in 1840 that banned such brutal employment of young boys. This ban was only enforced in London however, with other regions neglecting this law. However after 35 years of lobbying, Lord Shaftesbury ensured that the ban became nationally enforced via the Chimney Sweepers Act of 1875.

In that same year, Lord Shaftesbury went to be with the Lord; his labour for Christ was done and he was called home to enjoy eternal rest. His passing prompted much public sadness, with a public memorial, a statue of Anteros – the Angel of Christian charity, erected in his honour at Piccadilly Circus.

Lord Shaftesbury could have settled for a life of lavish comfort and stress free living. Instead he chose to use his privileged position to labour intensely for decades for the good of those who are weak and forgotten by society. This tremendous personal sacrifice was and still stands today as a wonderful reflection of the sacrifice Christ Jesus made, when He set aside His glory and majesty, so that He might come and live amongst us, experiencing all the sadnesses and hardships of this life, out of His divine compassion for fallen man. Now risen in all glory, sat at the right hand of the Father, He prays for His own, knowing our infirmities (Hebrews 4:15) and extending His eternal grace towards the repentant, believing heart.

Educate Your Children in God's Truth

Answers In Genesis is a company that my husband (editor of this magazine) often mentions in the resource centre. It has an absolute wealth of resources from books to DVD's and has what seems to be an incredible creation museum (sadly in the United States of America and not here in the United Kingdom), and an Ark encounter too. How I would absolutely love to take my children to these places and share such wonderful knowledge and news of the Lord with them in person and not just through the television or the internet. Being taught the truth is something children sadly do not receive in the curriculum here in the UK, instead they are taught such lies that we evolved from apes and that the world is millions of years old, along with dinosaurs living some 60 plus million years ago. It is up to us as parents, and family relations to teach our children the truth and to show them that God's words are the only words we can trust. Psalms 33:4, For the word of the Lord is right; and all his works are done in truth.





Ask for your eyes to be opened (fully), ask for your heart to be put on fire for the Lord, (most certainly not lukewarm) - The Lord will spit you out if you are lukewarm – Revelation 3:16, **So** then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. When we are given the task to educate our children, let's educate them in the truth, because if you knowingly lead another life down the wrong path then you will answer to the Lord even more sternly so than even for yourself. HE will rightfully judge you at your final hour. Romans 14:12 - So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

A Final Thought

Matthew 2:11 And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down and worshipped him

At this festive time of the year, as we consider the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, there is much that we can learn from the typical Nativity scene, not least from the wise men who famously followed a star from the East, in search of the prophesied King of the Jews. What might well grab our attention is the tremendous reverence these men showed to one who was, at a glance, a mere new-born infant. Consider the station of the wise men themselves. Judging by their scriptural knowledge and extravagant gifts, it seems clear these were exceptionally learned and wealthy men. Both knowledge and money are highly esteemed and coveted after by worldly people, are they not? How easy it would have been for the wise men to, instead of embarking on the great journey west, simply be puffed up in their own self-righteousness and seek acclaim from their contemporaries at home. Instead, the wisdom of these men is clearly displayed as they recognise, in the figure of a vulnerable infant, the Lord Himself incarnate, who had come to be made flesh and dwell among us (John 1:14). As we consider the scene of our Lord and Saviour being born in the manger at Bethlehem, do we have the wisdom to recognise that all of our worldly possessions and gifts are purely of His giving, and are we therefore moved to praise Him unreservedly for His amazing grace? Do we, as we think on our Lord's humble infancy, fall down and worship him, as the wise men so fittingly did? The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom (Psalm 111:10); whatever heights we may achieve in life, and whatever earthly joys we may attain, we must always be moved to praise and revere our Lord who was born in the flesh, lived the sinless life we're not capable of, died the death that we deserve on the cross, and rose again on the third day to conquer that last enemy, death (1 Corinthians 15:26), so that through simple, childlike faith in Him, we might attain everlasting life.
