

Textual Criticism

The most basic premise of modern textual criticism is that man does not have a verbally preserved text of scripture in either the Old Testament or the New Testament. Modern textual criticism seeks to restore or recover the original wording while plainly admitting it cannot accomplish such a goal and, in many cases, has no desire to do so. In 1882 when Westcott and Hort published their 'The New Testament in the Original Greek', in which they set forth the procedures for modern textual criticism, they repeatedly stated that textual critics cannot recover the actual text of the New Testament.

These admissions reveal that their procedure rests upon a foundation of unbelief: they did not believe God had preserved His written Words. Therefore, although the textual critic procedure used to produce the Greek and Hebrew texts behind the modern versions may have some merit for restoring secular texts, it has no merit for authoritatively establishing preserved Scripture. Bible versions such as the N.I.V. and the N.A.S.V., though perhaps translated by conservative, evangelical scholars, have the corrupting flaw of utilizing Hebrew and Greek texts produced by this unbelieving textual criticism (which edits the content of Scripture) also underlies and has shaped lower (textual) criticism (that edits the text of Scripture). This realization coincides with the fact that most textual critics today do not have saving faith. Indeed, neither Westcott nor Hort believed in the inerrancy of the original manuscripts, a position that denies the doctrine of inspiration.

The teaching of Matt5v18-19 also directly confronts a key issue in the criticism of the Old Testament text. That issue concerns the use of the Septuagint (LXX, a Greek translation) in determining the text when variant readings exist in the Old Testament Hebrew manuscripts. Many textual critics today put great weight upon readings found in the LXX that differ from the Hebrew Masoretic text because scholars assert that Jesus and the early church used the LXX as their Bible. However, in Matt5v18 Jesus clearly refers to the Hebrew, not Greek. Furthermore, in Lk11v50-51 (read it), Jesus references the Hebrew not the Greek Old Testament. The Hebrew book order has Genesis first (from which Jesus refers to Abel) and 2 Chronicles last (from which the reference to Zacharias) while the LXX ends with Malachi. In Lk24v44 Jesus also refers to the threefold



order of the Hebrew text e.g. Torah, Prophets, and Writings, an order not followed by the LXX. These definite references to the Hebrew text should settle the question concerning the authority of the Hebrew Masoretic text and overrule the preference that textual critics give to the readings of the LXX.

The comparison of these few but fundamental principles of modern textual criticism with Matt5v18-19 demonstrates that they contradict the teaching of the Bible about the preservation of its text. However, these principles have received widespread acceptance in conservative and fundamental colleges and seminaries. If Christians apply the teaching of

Jesus in this passage to textual criticism, they will reject the modern method that has produced the critical texts of the Old Testament and the Greek New Testament.

Jesus words demand that Christians concerned about textual criticism return to a position of faith, a position that builds its textual method on the teaching of the Bible. Modern textual criticism does not do this but ignores or discounts Jesus' exact assurance.

Whom then should Christians believe? Did God leave the preservation of the texts of the Old Testament and New Testament to fallible copyists? Do Christians have only the evidence of history to support the doctrine of preservation? Should believers put their faith in Bibles put together by unbelieving textual critics? Or did Jesus mean what He taught when He said, 'For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.'? Jesus taught that the authority of God's Word rested on the Divine preservation of the text. Belief in this doctrine leads men to reject modern textual criticism with its invalid texts and to accept the texts (and the methods that produced them) behind the King James Version of the Bible.

The Textus Receptus has been accepted by churches and the Textus Receptus text type was used by the churches from the first century. All others should be rejected as spurious. Believers need to receive only that text that has been protected and passed down by the New Testament local churches, such is the Scriptural format that God has chosen for the presentation and the preservation of His Word. Today there is a strong temptation on the issue of perfect preservation of God's Words, to please the academic lot, which will often reward such subjugation with the false label of scholarship. The world of modern Biblical scholarship dismisses the true Biblical believer for holding that every Word of God has been preserved in one edition. However, some of us are not looking for a lost Bible, we already have the one that New Testament started with, and we have long ago emptied our shelves of those corrupted ones.

The Omission of 1 John 5v7

The likes of the Cult the Jehovah's Witnesses love modern bibles because they often undermine any witness to the Deity of Christ. To them Jehovah is God. There is no Trinity. Jesus is the first thing Jehovah created. Jesus is not God. Before he lived on earth, he was Michael, the archangel. Jehovah made the universe through him. Further, the 'holy spirit' is not God, but an invisible active force from God.

Now, the Word of God does in fact give witness to Jesus being God. The Deity of Christ. However, one of the most famous references which is in the A.V. Bible is corrupted in modern bibles. The text is 1John5v7. To many believers who have done serious street witnessing (unlike most modern-day pastors and certainly 'scholars'), 1John5v7 carries importance when defending the Deity of our Lord to cultist etc. We need then to

look at this issue of bible perverting and consider what the Apostles wrote.

1 John 5:7 KJV
For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

The book of 1 John is written to give believers an assurance of eternal life. Believers are to put their faith in the Lord as the Messiah v1 and further as the Son of God v5. Such titles as these give a witness to the Deity of the Lord Jesus. Also, it should be noted that John refers to 'Jesus', thus speaking of His humanity. The Holy Spirit testifies to the human nature of Jesus in that the Divine Son comes to earth at the incarnation through the means of the water and the blood v6 as seen at Calvary. The Holy Spirit gives witness of the two facets of Christ's perfect humanity, and in doing so He reflects the doectic heresy that Jesus Christ only looked like a man.

Now, you may ask why does the Spirit give witness to the Divine and human nature of the Lord, the Son of God? Because three bear witness in heaven to this. These are the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost. However, the corrupt Critical Text of Westcott and Hort removes from v7 and the beginning of v8 the words 'in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth.' You see when the heart of v7 is cut out by the Critical Text then the text takes away the triune heavenly witness to Jesus Christ's nature. The three members of the Godhead testify to the Divine nature and Messianic authority of the perfect Man Jesus, but this is taken away if you cut out John's statement of 1 John 5v7. Further, taking away the Johannine Comma cuts off a clear reference to the Trinity. What does this do? Well, this leads some believers to doubt 1John5v7, they will not use it to defend the Deity of Christ.

Listen, if the Comma were absent, the inspired Words of John would have a grammatical error, gender discordance between the masculine participle 'bear record' (v7) and neuter appositives of v8 'spirit', 'water', 'blood' so, if the Critical Text is right, then there was a grammatical error in the originals. An error in the originals means that the Scriptures are not inerrant.

The fact is the doctrine of inerrancy would be meaningless with the Comma's absence, and the nature of God would be attacked for He would not have perfectly inspired His Word. However, the Comma is preserved in the Textus Receptus so, there is gender agreement between the masculine participle 'bear record' and the nouns 'Father', 'Word', and 'Holy Ghost'. As the Holy Ghost is a person, 'Spirit', takes a masculine participle in v8 consistent with and built upon His taking the masculine participle in v7. Since the dominant gender prevails, 'water' and 'blood' in v8 also are modified by the masculine participle. However, when the Third Person of the Godhead is spoken of independently in the New Testament 'Spirit' takes the neuter participle, article, and pronoun.

Now, because the Critical Text takes away the Johannine Comma, the masculine participle of v7a and the masculine anaphoric article of v8b becomes incongruous with customary gender usage for 'Spirit'. With the

inclusion of v7, one can esteem and admire the doctrine and harmony of the Comma and one can understand the significance of v9 and the witness of God concerning His Son.

The Critical Text is false, there is no doctrinal error in v7, grammatical agreement is found in v7, and v7 rings true to God's people. God continues to preserve His Word in the A.V. Bible. The field of Biblical Criticism, of which Textual Criticism is one facet, is a system of unbelief originated and promoted by apostates. Why are professing believers attracted to such a system of Godless teaching? Well one reason is probably because their Pastor teaches from a godless perverted counterfeit.

Dear Brother and Sister in Christ, the Trinity has been torn out of the verse in every 'new' corrupt 'bible' that followed the texts of Nestle, Aland and Metzger, and Westcott and Hort. However, there is an unbroken succession of witnesses to the verse starting with Old Syriac versions (A.D. 170), Tatian (A.D. 180), Old Latin versions and Tertullian (A.D. 200), Cyprian (A.D. 255), Priscillian and Athanasius (A.D. 350), Council of Carthage (A.D. 415), Jerome (A.D. 450), Cassiodorus (A.D. 480), Fulgentius (A.D. 510), Codex Wianbugensis (A.D. 750), miniscule manuscript 88 (1150), four different Waldensian Bibles (A.D. 600-1400), miniscule manuscript 629/14th Century and miniscule manuscript 61 (1519), the last manuscript is discounted by scholars because it was produced by the Catholics on the demand of Erasmus before he would put the verse in his Greek text. But manuscript 61 has affinities to the Old Syriac (A.D. 150) before any Syriac version was known in Europe (Moses Mardin – 1552). Moreover, with the 'Johannine Comma' left out, the genders of the witnesses in the first part of the verse do not match that of the 'Spirit', 'water', and 'blood' in v8; showing that something has been removed from the text. The verse has better internal and external evidence than the NIV and NASV readings for 1Tim3v16 and John1v18.

Removing the Johannine Comma cuts out the clearest single reference to the Trinity. Some will argue there are other places to prove the doctrine of the Three-in-One but the Devil is taking their powerful testimony from the believer. The Critical Text removes the Johannine Comma, but the verse was given by inspiration of God. For this reason, God has and will continue to preserve it. If one removes the text of 1John5v7 from Scripture (as the Critical Text and modern bibles do), the doctrine of the Trinity becomes a 'derived doctrine'. The Bible makes no other direct statement of this doctrine, but we derive it from the likes of Mt3v16-17 and 28v19. Does one discount or deny the doctrine of the Trinity? Absolutely not. All that deny it are either 'unbelievers', 'false teachers', 'heretics'. Let me tell you a fact. Most anti-Trinitarian apologists use the Critical Text as the basis of their false doctrines. They are liars, perverters of the Word of God and Hell bound.

We could go on endlessly writing thousands of words about corruptions in modern 'bibles', the evidence is massive, overwhelming and to a Holy Spirit enlightened heart irrefutable. Many of you are being misled (not necessarily purposefully), by your ministers who in turn have been misled by darkened souls called 'scholars'. So many of these men (scholars), have no saving faith, their unbelief is peddled to your Pastors etc. in modern bibles. Get an A.V. Bible. The Bible God loves and the Devil hates and ask God to speak to you from His Word.

Hope Against Hope

Romans 4:18 is a curious verse that blooms like the spring stirred flower when it is studied with an eager heart that trusts in the teaching of the Holy Spirit. In the AV/KJV Bible, is reads as follows:

Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, so shall thy seed be.

The translation crafted in all excellence of elegance and expression by the AV/KJV translators succinctly captures the soul deep war that exists each and every day within the heart of every believer in Christ. This war

being where does the heart place it's hope? Do we place our heart's hope in the abilities and offerings of this world? Or do we have our heart rest in the hope of the power and righteousness of God?

The true believer however, knows this hope to be what it actually is, a mirage that vanishes when you get close. This is the hope that Abraham was against, the hope that rested in the strength of the world. For what could the world offer a man who was nearly 100 years old and whose wife was an old lady, as they dreamed of parenting a child together? No IVF treatment is that effective! Instead, Abraham embraced a hope that is diametrically opposed to this worldly hope, a hope that resides purely on that belief that with God all things are



possible (Matthew 19:26). Abraham had chosen his side in the battle over where a life places its hope, in the world or in God. He had decided on the merits of all the abundant evidence that God is exactly who He says He is, the Almighty Creator God (just stop and think of the staggering complexity all around you and ask yourself, did all this happen by chance?!) and so placed his hope in God and thus against the world. This is the war in the heart of man that the AV/KJV translators captured so wonderfully back in 1611, and its power, brevity, eloquence and truth still speak boldly this day.

This identification of the life of a believer in Christ experiencing spiritual warfare on the most fundamental levels of life (as in where one places their hope), is a stunning continuation of the Scriptural observation that we battle not against flesh and blood, but against powers and principalities of the air (Ephesians 6:12). This highlighting of the true nature of the battle in which we soldiers of Christ engage in is entirely missed in the NIV for example, as Romans 4:18 states in this Alexandrian translation:

Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it has been said to him, "So shall your offspring be."

Now reading this translation of the Romans 4:18, we lose so very much in comparison to the richness and accuracy of the AV/KJV. Firstly, let us note that in the NIV, we read that Abraham hoped against **all** hope. Clearly then Abraham, to successfully act against **all** hope, he would have to act against the hope that rests in God. Furthermore, if Abraham acted against **all** hope, as the text reads, then what is this mystical, ethereal hope in which he finds strength in that has not been already eliminated when he had already decided to go against **all** hope? In this corruption of God's Word, the power of resting in the hope of God's ability to do anything has been robbed from us, something that the devil himself has been seeking to do since Eden.

Speaking of Eden, if we go by the AV/KJV, we see a glorious fulfilment of that wondrous promise first given to mankind of a coming Redeemer, delivered all the way back in Genesis 3:15. It reads in the AV/KJV:

'And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy **seed** and her **seed**; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.'

Can you see it? This seed that was promised would flow through Abraham, the content of the study in Romans 4, was first revealed back to Adam and Eve! The usage of that one word draws all these texts, all these events of history separated by millenniums together to reveal the seed of whom God speaks to be none other than his only Begotten Son Jesus Christ. This city being the city made by the hands of God Himself, where we will dwell with the one who is the hope of our days forevermore. Amen.

The Scientific Knowledge of Job

Many scholars believe the book of Job to be the oldest book of the Bible, dating back to the time of Abraham or even prior, thus making his life around 2000-1900 BC. What is extraordinary about this account of Job is not just it's ancient dating but also the array of accurate scientific statements about nature and the universe found littered throughout the book's pages. The following is a basic list of some of those astonishingly accurate declarations made by Job that modern science has verified as 100 per cent correct.

- 1) Job 26:7 the Earth free-floats in space, hanging on nothing. All other ancient texts speculate that the world was upheld in its position by the god Atlas who carried the world on his back, or it rested on the shell of a giant turtle. The Book of Job stands unique in all ancient texts as having correctly determined that the Earth does hang on nothing in Space. How would Job have known that in 2000 BC unless divinely inspired?
- 2) Job 38:6 the oceans contain springs. Until very recently, it was believed that the oceans were fed only by rivers and rainfall. It wasn't until the 1970's that deep-sea submarines had been designed that were able to withstand the enormous pressures exerted by the seas at great depths, thus enabling the study of deep-sea life and activity. What was discovered was that indeed there are springs at the depths of the ocean that feed the seas along with rivers and rainfall, just as Job observed 4000 years ago! How

- did Job know this given the technology to build submarines able to withstand 6000 pounds of pressure per square inch (thus able to travel deep into the depths of the oceans to find these springs) was not available to mankind until 1970 AD?!
- 3) Job 38:24 Light can be divided. Sir Issac Newton 'discovered' in the 17th century AD, that white light can be divided or 'parted' into a spectrum of seven colours and then recombined again. Many people think this scientific breakthrough was made in the 1600's AD, whereas God revealed it to mankind through Job in 2000 BC!
- 4) Job 38:29-30 Ice Age inferred. Almost all scientists will acknowledge that our world has experienced an Ice-Age, with both Creationists and Evolutionists agreeing that the world bears the scars of this period of history, and we still see it's leftovers in the form of the Poles and glaciers. The Post-Flood world would've been highly conducive for such a sudden and swift Ice-Age to descend upon the Earth and affect huge swathes of land in both hemispheres with snowy tundra's stretching thousands of miles. This would've likely been the world that Job knew well, with lands not far to the north of his Mesopotamian dwelling being impacted by this dramatic Ice-Age and so we see a reference to this climate made from an eye-witness viewpoint in the Book of Job.
- 5) Job 10:8 Embryonic development. Job observes how the Lord fashions and knits us together in the womb, highlighting the incredible intricacy and care that takes place during the development of every life in the womb. Science was unaware of the miracle of embryonic development until very recently, further making us ask the question, 'how could Job know this 4000 years ago?' The answer, he was told by God so that future generations could read of the life of Job and see how advanced ancient man truly was and how God is the Creator of all things.
- 6) Job 36:27-28 the Hydrological Cycle. Job speaks of the cycle known by modern Meteorologists as the hydrological cycle (evaporation, atmospheric transportation, distillation, and precipitation) to explain why rain falls, rivers flow but seas do not rise. Whilst other ancient peoples speculated on strange and bizarre theories to explain this amazing cycle, the Bible alone gets the process 100 per cent accurately from 2000 BC!
- 7) Job 9:8 The universe is expanding. In the 20th century, most scientists (such as Einstein) held to the view that the universe was not moving and instead was static. Some others thought that it should be collapsing due to gravity. Then in 1929, Edwin Hubble, the astronomer, discovered that distant galaxies were moving away from Earth, and that the further away they were, the faster they were moving. This revolutionised the field of Astronomy and Einstein admitted his mistake. If only he had read and believed what Job noted in chapter 9 verse 8, he would've been correct in the first place.
- 8) Job 38:19 Light travels in a path. The Bible describes light as having a 'way' (Hebrew: *derek*, a travelled road or path). Up until the 17th century, it was believed that light was transmitted instantaneously. Today we know that light is a form of energy that moves at 186,000 miles per second in a straight line or 'way'. Again, how would Job know this unless divinely inspired to speak on such wonders of Creation.
- 9) Job 28:25 Air has weight. It was once believed by a great many academics, that air was weightless. However, Job spoke authoritatively that God sets "the weight for the winds.' It wasn't until recent studies, that meteorologists found that the average thunderstorm contains thousands of tons of rain. To be able to carry this massive load, air must have mass, just as Job spoke 4000 years ago!
- 10) Job 30:1-8 Cavemen identified in the Bible. In this passage, Job speaks of "base men" who dwelt in the "caves of the earth" and were "viler than the earth". These people were the social outcasts, the "children of fools" who lived as vagabonds in the caves that litter the earth. These cave dwellers were therefore just as human as you and I, not neolithic creatures who went around hunched over carrying clubs and speaking in animalistic noises. Unsurprisingly, increasing discoveries are being made to the advanced abilities of these cave dwellers that are reflecting all the traits of human living, confounding Evolutionary scientists but proving the words of the Bible nicely.
- 11) Job 38:31 The Pleiades and Orion star clusters. Pleiades, as a star cluster is gravitationally bound. However, the Orion cluster is not so and instead loose and disintegrating due to the gravity being too weak in this cluster to hold it all together. 4000 years ago, Job asked the question "Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion?" How did Job know 4000 years ago that Pleaides is bound together by gravity and yet Orion is weak in its binding in comparison?! We, as an advanced modern people, only found this scientific fact out recently, yet Job knew it thousands of years ago with remarkable accuracy of description.

12) Job 39 - Understanding of animal instincts. Many people enjoy watching nature documentaries as they learn about dsicoveroes of how and why animals behave in certain ways at certain times. Well, chapter 39 of the Book of Job is a remarkable insight into the instincts and behaviours of a wide variety of creatures. From the migration of the hawk to the ostrich's care for their young, this wonder filled chapter reveals much of the intricate animal behaviours that secular zoology took millennia to catchup in knowledge of.

In conclusion, it is a brilliant act of God to have so many tremendous scientific insights revealed in the Holy Scriptures via what is believed to be the oldest written book of the Bible. This subtle yet powerful detail bears witness to the advanced nature of ancient man (making a mockery of evolutionary theory), and to the all-knowing and unchanging nature of God. For through His Word He shows us that He has always loved and cared for His Creation, and that because He is unchanging, we can rest in His goodness and mercy knowing that He cares for us just as much today. Once again, the Pope is the driving force behind the push to unite all the world's religions into one brotherhood of man. This brotherhood will then come together in one universal religion that will be the worship of the Beast seen in the Book of Revelation. The Laodicean Church And Us

Revelation 3:14-21 gives us an insight into how our Lord views the Laodicean church. If you subscribe to a dispensational interpretation of the seven churches of Revelation, Christ's words have a heavy if ultimately hopeful tone for we Christians today. Yet is there any evidence from history that such a dispensational view of Scripture is correct? Well, let's assess what history has to say on this important and much discussed topic.

The Laodicean church was a very real church that existed during the age of the Apostles. Located in modern Turkey, the church in Laodicea was possibly planted by Epaphras, a disciple of the Apostle Paul's. Epaphras planted the church at nearby Colossae (Colossians 1:6-7), so many infer that Epaphras was involved in the establishing of the Laodicean church.

Laodicea was an extremely wealthy and prominent city in the eastern regions of the Roman empire due to its success as a banking and textile production hub for the empire. Located at a crossroads between the various regions of the empire such as Ephesus, Smyrna and Sardis, the city flowed with the riches of trade and

enterprise. This well-established historical fact verifies everything declared by Christ in Revelation 3:17, that Laodicea was distracted by its enjoyment of wealth and worldly splendour.

Many scholars believe the Book of Revelation was written during the reign of Emperor Domitian (81-96 AD).



Christian faith was heavily targeted for violent persecution.

This would place the words of God delivered unto the Apostle John to come at a time when the Christian Church was undergoing great persecution for its refusal to worship the Emperor as a living god. Domitian was notorious even in his own time, as he was the first Emperor to proclaim himself a god, as previous emperors were deified after their death (somewhat ironic). Domitian persecuted anyone who would not participate in the imperial cult (worship of emperors and dynastic families) meaning that the

This persecution of Christian churches and its followers left the wealthy Christians of Laodicea with a dilemma. Were they to refuse participation in the imperial cult and thus endure great persecution by the Roman authorities, interestingly including the removal of the ability to buy and sell within the Roman empire (a preview of what will happen to those who refuse the mark of the Beast) and stand by the Gospel of Jesus Christ? Or were they to compromise and adapt to the Roman requirements so that they could retain their worldly success and wealth without upheaval or persecution? It appears from history that many within the Laodicean church compromised their faith and timidly went along with the demands of worship of the imperial cult. This stood them against other churches of the age, such as the church in Smyrna which defended the faith against the imperial cult and subsequently endured great persecution from Rome. Therefore, it is not difficult to see why Christ would proclaim the Laodicean church to be 'lukewarm' for it had tried to keep its faith in Christ Jesus yet appease the powers of Rome so that it could remain prominent and wealthy. Doesn't this sound like much of modern Christendom today?!

Now, if Biblical prophecies often have two fulfilments, an immediate or near time fulfilment along with a more distant in time fulfilment (a position held by many prominent theologians and scholars for centuries), then why can't the words spoken to the seven churches in the opening chapters of the Book of Revelation have a similar feature? Each of the seven churches had distinct features, traits and gifts at the time of writing of Revelation, meaning the words of Christ unto them had a relevant immediate meaning. This would explain the corrective words towards the church at Laodicea in light of their spiritual compromise, against the praise of Smyrna for example for its defence of the faith against persecution. Yet what if these words were markers also of how the Church of Christ would behave and move throughout the generations of time until Christ's return?

Dispensationalists argue from a position of historical strength and veracity, that the true Church has mirrored the characteristics and outworkings of the seven churches as consecutively listed in Revelation with startling similarity. Let's look briefly at this thought now:

Ephesus (beginning with the sending out of the Apostles by Christ in Matthew 10 to death of last Apostle in approx. 90AD) – the earnest labour of the infant church to spread the Gospel reflects well the praise given to this church in Revelation 2:2. Whilst Christ's words of correction for this church 'leaving its first love' speak of the Apostle Paul's marvelling at how there were many in the infant church who were getting pulled away from their faith by 'another gospel'.

Smyrna (90 AD to 325 AD approximately) – The acknowledgement of the Smyrnian church's enduring of great tribulation by Christ (Revelation 2:9) mirrors well the enormity of persecution faced by the early Church as it spread throughout the Roman empire during this period of history. Furthermore, Christ speaking of the worldly poverty, but spiritual wealth of this church reflects the torment endured by those early saints as they

sought to protect the Word of God from those who would corrupt its content with heresies such as Gnosticism.

Pergamos (325 AD to 500 AD approximately) – The words of Christ as He speaks in Revelation 2:12-16, reflects the costly stand many made against the emerging Papacy in Rome and its corruptions of the faith, yet also the falling of others who embraced this corruption and led to the committing of fornication by adhering to the false teachings of infant Roman Catholicism.

Thyatira (500 AD to 1000 AD approximately) – Seen in Revelation 2:18-28, Christ's initial words of praise highlight the zealous work of those such as Columba, who earnestly spread the good news of the Gospel bringing hope to many. Yet the heavy words of Christ against the same church speaks well of the continuing corruption of the faith by the ever-growing Roman Catholic church, here depicted as the woman Jezebel for such was her wickedness. Just as Jezebel had men of God killed in great numbers, so too did the Catholic Church in this age. Christ had given this corrupt church (Rome) time to repent of its evil and it's falling away from it's first love that was the pure Gospel of Christ Jesus. Yet it did not repent, and so Christ cast them off as they descended further into mysticism and evil.

Sardis (1000 AD to 1500 AD approximately) – Depicted in Revelation 3:1-5, we again see an accurate reflection in Church history of what Christ declared unto the church in Sardis. This was the age of darkness, as Rome held power across great swathes of land and numerous nations, holding them all blind to God through its corrupted faith now fully embracing of mystery religions and mysticism. Yet, even in this age of spiritual darkness, there remained a few who received Christ's praise. Men such as John Wycliffe, the 'morning star of the Reformation', those who held to the pure Gospel of Jesus Christ and fought against the tyranny and corruptions of Papal Rome.

Philadelphia (1500 AD to 1900 AD approximately) - What era of Church history more accurately reflect the high praise reserved for the church in philadephia, as seen in Revelation 3:7-12, than the era of the Reformation and the subsequent spread of the Gospel of Christ Jesus across the globe! Note how even the verse numbers of this passage 7 and 12, reflect the perfection and purity of God, for this was the age of the bringing of the Pure Word of God to the world via the printing of the King James Bible. A Bible still loved and adored the world over and still bringing hearts to Christ this very hour, making a mockery of those who call it antiquated. It was this holding on to the purity of God's Word that meant it was kept from the 'hour of temptation' by Christ, for by the truth of its purity, the Church was kept from the corruptions of Rome and movements such as ecumenism which both seek to lure men away from the truth of God's eternal Word, and back into the darkness of spiritual fornication.

Laodicea (1900 AD to present day) - How true are Christ's words (Revelation 3:14-21) to the Laodiceans are to us also as Christians today. The Church is truly wealthy in worldly terms, just as the Laodicean church of the Apostolic age was, particularly in the western world where megachurches are plentiful, and the Church of England holds assets worth billions of pounds. Yet we are naked in our wealth, for we traded away a pure Word of God for a pantheon of approximations of God's Word that are limp and impotent, unable to provide clear teaching that stands against the evils of this modern world. Our eyes are sore from reading this diluted Word of God, they are in need of soothing from the eyesalve that is the Pure Word of God once enjoyed by the blessed age of the Philadelphian church. The compromise of the Laodiceans under the rule of Emperor Domitian, is being mirrored all the more clearly by our modern Church and its desire to embrace ecumenism and appease Rome once again. Yet think on how there are 7 verses in this address to the lukewarm Laodicean church. It's almost a symbol of how the purity of God's Word, as reflected in the number 7, still exists to be used and wielded, if only this age would see it. Hope remains where God's Pure Word remains.

Could it be therefore, that dispensationalism holds truth in it? Could it be that the immediate setting of the seven churches of Revelation and their consecutive addresses by Christ Jesus have been mirrored so remarkably throughout the subsequent generations of mankind? If so, then we are truly within the Laodicean era, as the present state of much of modern Christendom reflects Christ's words oh so accurately. If so, then we are in the closing days of time, for there is no other church that follows the Laodicean. As a result, Christ's

words that He stands at the door and knocks is for us today. Open the door to Him now and He will dine with us, and we will have wondrous communion with God. In doing so, we will overcome the temptations of embracing a corrupted faith and be lifted by the grace of Christ Jesus to sit with Him in His throne. What a glory for those who hold true to the faith, for those who refuse to compromise with diluted and corrupted gospels. The hour of temptation is upon us. Many are falling already, make sure you are not one of them.

Light In The Darkness In Iran

Isalm in Iran is in trouble. Increasing numbers of Iranians are becoming disenchanted with the Muslim religion after having lived under its oppressive regime for decades. Bible study groups are promptly broken up by armed police with the attendees forcibly ejected and sent home under threats of violence, whilst those leading the gatherings are arrested and thrown into prison. Crossways mega-church in Cinncinati, USA (see picture), is the third highest attended church in America. Whilst the main pastor is not a Youtube darling, he is a powerful influence upon many in the United States who form their views on the Bible and Christianity upon what he teaches and preaches.

This huge sway he holds over many Christians in America prompted one local Christian to attend one of Crossways services with an aim to ask the pastor as to the nature of his vast congregation. On quizzing the

The questions towards the pastor from the local Christian continued as he observed that Crossways church services do not speak about the Gospel. Instead, they are encouragement meetings that are designed to 'meet people where they're at' and help them with their issues in life through positivity, counselling etc, etc. The pastor furthered on this by observing that the church holds smaller groups where the Gospel is then given. Challenged by the local Christian as to how many within the general congregation actually attend these smaller groups, the pastor replied, 'about 25 per cent.' Now worried about the state of the megachurch, the local Christian highlighted to the pastor that 75 per cent of those who attend Crossways never hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ! What kind of Christian church leaves 75 per cent its congregation deaf to the good news of the salvation of believing mankind through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ?!

The now deeply concerned local Christian pressed further and asked the pastor of Crossways as to how the congregation hears Biblical messages/sermons or learn of the Scriptures? The pastor responded with bewilderment, 'Why would they want to learn the Bible?' Words fail. An American megachurch, the third largest in America has **no** Gospel preaching, has **no** desire to teach the Bible and as a result 90 per cent of the attendees leave within two years with a bitter taste in their mouth over Christianity. Ocean Salt Leaves Bad Taste In Evolution's Mouth

I came across a short video on YouTube by Creation Ministries International that discussed how the salt levels seen in the world's oceans, leave a sizeable problem for deep age, old earth evolutionary timeline. In nature, salt levels in the oceans are subject to change due to rainfall washing salt from the earth out into rivers and then the seas. Added to this consistent injection of salt to the oceans, are subterranean seas that similarly add salt content to the world's oceans. Then when ocean waters are evaporated as part of the water cycle, the salt from the evaporated water which later becomes rain, is left behind in the oceans, further adding to the steady increase in the oceans salt levels.



Recent studies conducted by scientists Steve Austin and Russel Humphries, have looked at the implications of this natural process, and using secular models (so no Creationist 'bias') to estimate the age the oceans of the world according to the rates of salt injection and salt removal (lower than amounts of salt being put into the oceans). The absolute maximum age the oceans can be according to secular models no less, is 62 million years old. This figure came

from the assumption that the world's oceans had **no** salt content at all at their beginning (a sizeable assumption to say the least!) and that the rate of salt injection into the oceans was at the lowest amount model estimations allow, whilst the rate of salt removal from the oceans was at its highest allowed estimates. In other words, every favourable possibility to tilt variables of the investigation to suit the evolutionary theory of an old earth was adopted. However, the absolute oldest even this setup could offer was 62 million years, or $1/50^{\text{th}}$ of the age of the world's oceans declared by evolutionary scientists. A problem for Evolution indeed!

Now when the initial levels of ocean salt were adjusted to just a low amount (to still accommodate sceptics and support salt-water living creatures), and the rates of salt injection and removal were altered to more expected, non-extreme levels, the age of the world's oceans came within the Biblical timeframe. Unsurprisingly the data, even using secular models, supports a young earth just as we read of in the Book of Genesis.

An anti-Creation scientist named Glenn Moreton tried to dismiss this research by suggesting that much of the salt that existed in the oceans came from subterranean seas via deep sea vents. These vents would release hot water into the oceans causing the chemical albite to form which then absorbed much of the sodium content of the oceans. This would therefore allow for a much older timeline for the world's oceans than what the evidence points towards. However, when hot water cools, as it does in the oceans today, albite disintegrates into chloride thereby releasing back into the seas the sodium it had once absorbed. Therefore, there is **no** net-removal of salt from the oceans by this process. Glenn Moreton's proposal never gained scientific traction as this problem was obvious from the get-go and left evolutionary science with a big problem still.

It is interesting to note, that this issue of oceanic salt levels pointing to a young earth, has been known since the 19th century! In 1899, a scientific paper acknowledged this whole issue as a problem for old earth theory but was quietly hushed up, as all Evolution exposing discoveries are.

So, when God challenged Job as to whether Job was able to "shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth" (Job 38:8) and thereby control the mighty oceans boundaries and limits, maybe He was not only highlighting not only the power and expanse of the seas that rest under His hand, but also all the content within. That content, down to the microscopic level declares that it was all crafted by Him, just as He has revealed to us through His Word the Holy Bible.

Dark History of Karl Marx

How many people are aware that Karl Marx, the father of Communism and Socialism, was a playwright and poet? These barely known writings give us a valuable insight into the mind of a man whose teachings have brought about the death of untold millions and are plaguing much of western society today (increasingly so in our own nation).

"Invocation of One of Despair", was an early poem written by Marx. In it he penned this line that reveals unmistakeably the heart of a man who despised God. Marx wrote, "So a god has snatched from me my

all...Nothing but revenge is left to me!" Before we are to adopt the thoughts and teachings of anyone, we must carefully judge and test the manner of their thoughts and life, for such an approach is Scriptural (1 Thessalonians 5:21). Here we see that from a young and formative age, Marx had already set his heart firmly against God to such levels that he sought to attempt to take revenge on Him! Such a desire smacks of Satan himself and reveals unmistakeably the dark heart of all political/social teachings born by this evil mind.

If you feel that I am being overly zealous in my stance that Marx spoke with the tongue of devils, let's look at his own words as to how he would go about his plan to get revenge against God. Later in the same poem, Marx declares that he will "build (his) throne high overhead." The nature of this throne he goes on to share will be "Cold, tremendous shall its summit be. /For its bulwark-superstitious dread, /For its Marshall-blackest agony. /Who looks on it with a healthy eye, /Shall turn back, struck deathly pale and dumb; /Clutched by blind and chill Mortality/May his happiness prepare its tomb."

Any student of poetry, nay anyone with a eyes to read these words cannot help but be moved to a horrible shudder by the hellish nature of Marx's writing. He holds a sick adoration of death, a hallmark of all followers of Satan, as he leads the reader down into the tomb via his dark musings and longings. In this piece of poetry, it is not hard to see the heart of the ideology that has killed so, so many lives it boggles the mind, and gives credence to those who say that Communism was never written to be a hope for humanity, but instead a way of Marx to enact his murderous hatred upon mankind. Marx's disturbed and devilish desires mirror those of Satan, as we read in Isaiah 14:12-14 of how Lucifer fell from heaven to become Satan, turning to use God's own creation that is mankind, as a weapon to seek to gain revenge on the Lord God.

In his 1839 play *Oulanem*, (see picture) Marx produced a Faustian themed (a theme that centres on the premise of someone making a bargain with the devil to gain power, wealth, etc) play that further spoke of the depths of evil that lurked within him and was unleashed onto the world via his *Communist Manifesto*. The name *Oulanem*, was believed by many to an act of blasphemy as it sounds as a backward pronunciation of *Emmanuel*, one of the titles of Christ Jesus. This would make sense, as many occultists seek to convey hidden meanings within texts when they are spoken backwards.

The play begins as follows, "Ruined! Ruined! My time has clean run out! The clock has stopped, the pygmy house has crumbled. Soon I shall embrace eternity to my breast, and soon I shall howl gigantic curses at mankind...If there is a Something which devours, I'll leap within it, though I bring the world to ruins – the world which bulks between me and the abyss, I will smash to pieces with my enduring curses."

There are no words to aptly convey the evil contained in this opening to Marx's play. The central character, which many scholars and biographers of Marx all agree to be autobiographical, has a deep desire to embrace 'Something' (note the use of the capital letter!) that he knows is truly evil, but has no desire to avoid it. Instead, he wants only to use it to unleash horror upon the world unendingly, such is his hatred of humanity. Is this the mind we want to follow in our societal makeup?! Those nations who have embraced Marx's hellish vision have given ample evidence that this political movement is born of hell!

In case the reader is still unconvinced of Marx's adoration of death and the devil, let's look at one more of his poems. *The Player* (also known as *The Fiddler*) contains this satanic imagery, "Look now, my

blood-dark sword shall stab/Unerringly within thy soul. /God neither knows nor honors art. /The hellish vapours rise and fill the brain/Till I go mad and my heart is utterly changed...See this sword - the Prince of Darkness sold it to me...Ever more boldly I play the dance of death."


This is the heart and mind of a man given unto darkness. A man who sought no communion with God, no desire to walk in the light of Christ Jesus. Instead, Marx chose to wield a sword of death given to him by the Prince of Darkness, no less. This man Karl Marx brought a hellish vision to the world, a vision that is spreading further and further upon these very shores via 'woke' ideology.

The biographer Robert Payne, in his 1968 book *Marx*, spoke on these disturbed works, "Marx is here celebrating a satanic mystery...Marx clearly enjoyed the horrors he depicted, and we shall find him enjoying in very much the same way the destruction of whole classes in the *Communist Manifesto*. He was a man with a peculiar faculty for relishing disaster...(Marx) had the Devil's view of the world, and the Devil's malignity. Sometimes he seemed to know that he was accomplishing works of evil."






