MINUTES FROM

November 6, 2025 Special Meeting

Commissioners Phil Guthrie, Tim Larson and Ray Schmitten met at the Dryden Fire Station – Community Room. Also in attendance were Deputy Fire Chief Steven Spies, Kip Higdon, Jerrad Collins, Michelle Mazzola, and Dwight Remick. The meeting was called to order at 3:00 PM by Commissioner Guthrie.

The purpose of the meeting was to Certify results of the August 5, 2025 levy election to be submitted to the County Assessor's office and the Legislative Authority at the office of the County Commissioners for collection in 2026.

Financial reports for 2025 were presented by Dwight with a specific focus on how the current year operations and budget will be impacted by the increased funding provided by the Levy Lid Lift passage and FEMA grant that was received. Dwight also presented information regarding the work that had been done to begin the process for creating the 2026 budget. This information included updating tax estimates provided by the County Assessor's office to be able to project tax revenues as required for the formal Certification.

A motion to approve Resolution 2025-05 Certification of August 5, 2025 Levy Election was made by Commissioner Schmitten and seconded by Commissioner Larson. The motion was unanimously approved.

The related Levy Certification form was also reviewed and signed by Commissioner Guthrie.

The meeting was adjourned by Commissioner Guthrie at 3:45 PM.
