

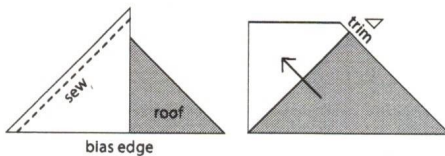
ASSEMBLY

All seams are sewn with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance

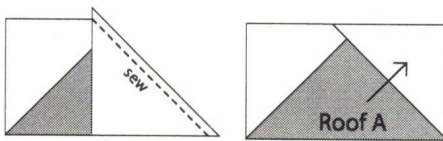
Making one house

There are 2 types of roofs;
 roof A and roof B with a chimney.
 To make roof A or B select the following:
 roof: 1-5" triangle
 background: 1-4" square, cut in half
 on the diagonal

Sew the a 4" background triangle to the
 roof triangle. Press and trim.

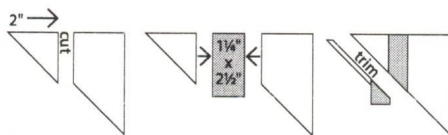


If you are making roof A, add a 4"
 background triangle to the same roof
 triangle. Press. See trimming.

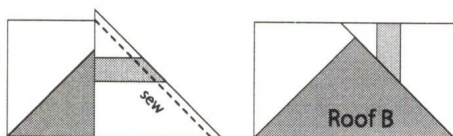


If you are making roof B, select
 1-1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " chimney rectangle.

Cut a 4" background triangle 2" from
 the point as shown. Assemble the
 chimney, press and trim.

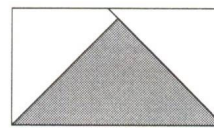
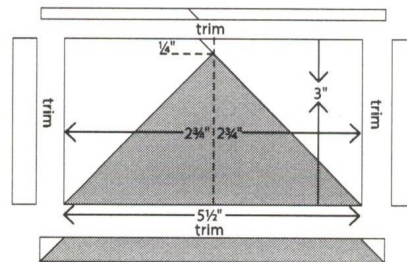


Add the chimney to the roof.
 See trimming.



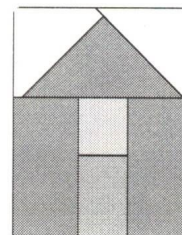
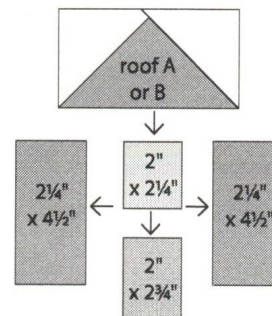
Trimming

Trim roof A or B to 3" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " as shown.
 Be sure to leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance at
 the top of the roof.

 unfinished

To make the house select the following:
 house: 1-2" x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle
 1-2" x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle
 2-2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
