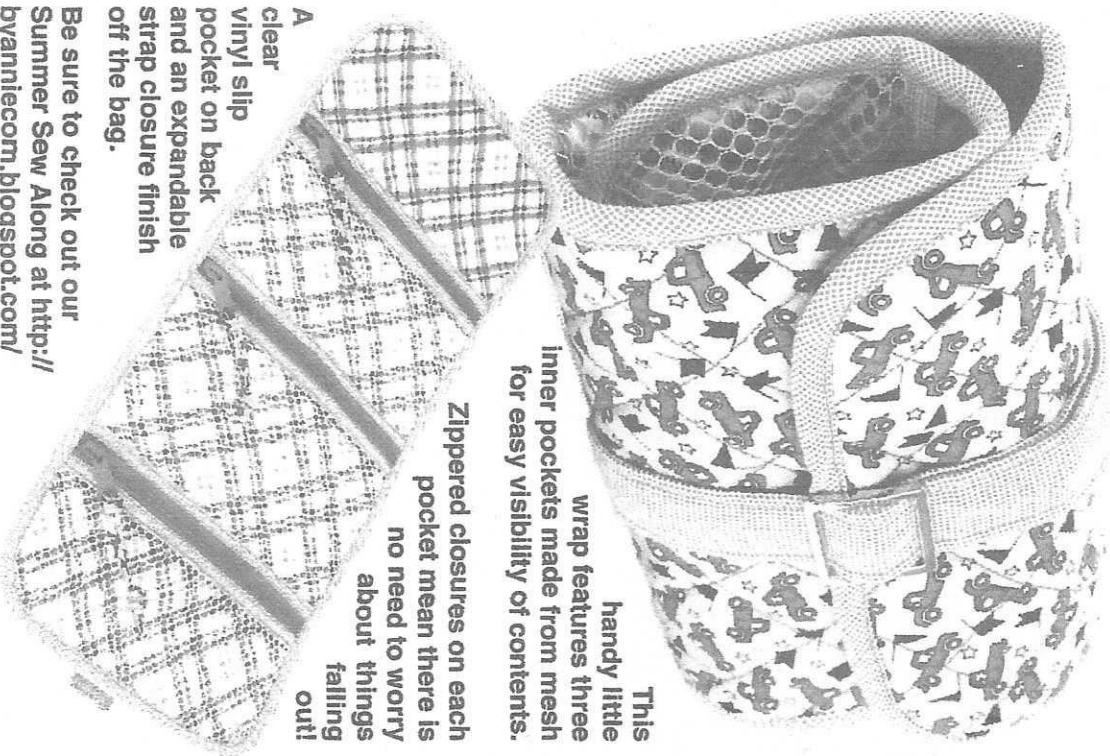


Stash and Dash

This handy little wrap features three inner pockets made from mesh for easy visibility of contents.

Zippered closures on each pocket mean there is no need to worry about things falling out!

A clear vinyl slip pocket on back and an expandable strap closure finish off the bag.

This handy little wrap features three inner pockets made from mesh for easy visibility of contents. Each pocket has a zipper closure — no need to worry about things falling out! A clear vinyl slip pocket on back and an expandable strap closure finish off the bag.

Stash and Dash is perfect to use as an emergency car kit, first aid kit, organizer for supplies (sewing, cosmetics, or office), kid's quiet book, or purse organizer — the possibilities are endless! How will you use Stash and Dash?

Supplies needed:	Amount needed:
Main fabric* (body of organizer) <small>* Not suitable for directional fabrics. Busy fabrics are best as they will hide stitching lines.</small>	Fat quarter
Lining fabric (lining of organizer)	Fat quarter
Contrasting fabric (bindings and strap)	1/2 yard
ByAnnie's Soft and Stable (stabilizer)	4 1/2" x 3 1/2" <i>included</i>
Mesh fabric, light-weight or mid-weight (inner pockets)	10" x 10" <i>included</i>
Clear vinyl, heavyweight (back pocket)	10" x 10" <i>included</i>
Zippers <small>We prefer handbag zippers. They are sturdier and have an extra large pull. Their extra-wide zipper tape also makes them easier to install.</small>	Three 10" or longer or One 30" double-slide handbag zipper with an extra zipper pull
1" polypro strapping	1/2 yard <i>included</i>
1" wide-mouth slider (strap closure) (HAR1-AB-350 or HAR1-N-350)	1" x 10" <i>included</i>
Thread for quilting and assembly <small>We love threads from Superior Threads: www.superiorthreads.com</small>	We prefer So Fine! #50 for both quilting and assembly on this project.
Basting tape (optional) <small>Helpful for attaching zippers to mesh pockets</small>	One package

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Stash and Dash

I hope you enjoy making this handy foldover wrap to carry makeup, toiletries, first aid items, and more. Each easy-to-make bag features an easy-to-grab handle, a secure zippered closure, and interior mesh pockets.

The instructions have been designed so that you can check off each step as you proceed, making it easy to keep track of where you are in the process. Please be sure to read *all* the instructions before beginning.

In addition to the supplies listed on the back, you will also need these tools:

- sewing machine with 1/4" foot, zipper foot, and walking foot *Available at www.ByAnnie.com
- steam iron and ironing board
- rotary cutter, mat and quilter's ruler (I used 6" x 12", 6" x 24", 12 1/2" square, and 20 1/2" square rulers for this project.)
- pins (The long yellow-topped quilting pins* work best.)
- easily removable marker such as a Chaco Liner Pen Style Marker* for marking lines
- stiletto* (to hold pieces in place as you stitch — especially helpful when sewing on bindings)
- wooden pressing tool* (for pressing seams — helpful but not essential)
- Wonder Clips* (a great alternative to pins to hold pieces in place)
- a 12mm/1/2" bias tape maker* is helpful but not essential for making the zipper pulls

Homework: Cutting Instructions

NOTE: Measurements are listed as length (lengthwise grain) of fabric x width (crosswise grain of fabric).

From main fabric cut:

- body of organizer — 10" x 20"
- zipper pulls — three 1" x 12"

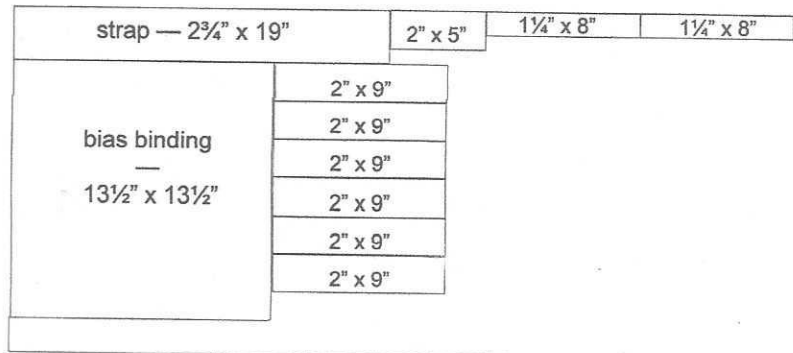
From lining fabric cut:

- lining of organizer — 10" x 20"

From contrasting fabric cut (see Cutting Layout on page 5):

- strap — 2 3/4" x 19"
- bindings for vinyl pocket — one 2" x 5" and two 1 1/4" x 8"
- bias binding — 13 1/2" x 13 1/2"
- bindings for zippered mesh pockets — six 2" x 9"

Cutting Layout for Contrasting Fabric



Cut out these labels to pin to your fabric as you cut it
