Workshop Sample: *Floating World*, 36" x 36"

In this two-day workshop, you make a curvy-pieced quilt top of your own design. You start by translating simple doodles into block designs and transferring the line work to freezer paper for making patterns. You then walk through the steps for making a fabric version of your custom patterns. By the end of the workshop, you will have the competence and confidence to add curves to your future quilt projects.

Basic Sewing Tools Needed

Sewing machine, 1/4" presser foot, bobbins
Sharp machine needles, not universal needles (2 or 3)
Cloth scissors AND paper scissors
Seam ripper
Thread snips or small scissors
(Helpful) Clear grid ruler, 18" or 24" long, rotary cutter

Personal Sewing Supplies Needed

Lead pencil and good eraser
Lots of fine pins and a pin cushion
Fine black Sharpie
Freezer paper, 4 pieces, 18" x 18"

Fabrics and Thread Needed

Five to six different fabrics—four to five that coordinate and one that is somewhat unexpected

For 45" fabric: .5 to 1 yard each

For yukata cottons (14" wide): 1 to 2 yards each—available at www.okanarts.com/shop

For larger patterns, bring the greater amount of fabric

(Feel free to bring extra fabrics and Patricia will help you select your project fabrics)

Matching thread, 100% cotton 50wt.
