All fabrics for this class need to be **HAND DYED or SOLID COTTONS.**

24” X 24” piece of thin cotton batting.

1/2 yard cheese cloth.

1/4 yard dark brown fabric.

1/2 yard medium yellow/green (think of lemons) fabric.

1/2 yard white fabric.

Paper/fabric scissors.

Pencil.

Purple disappearing pen (air).

Basic sewing supplies.

Three bobbins filled with cream or white thread.

Spools of thread: yellow, brown, white and light yellow/green.

Sewing machine.
