

# Pond stocking guide for one acre Pond

Your fish may be stocked anytime. New pond's should be 3/4 full. A good food chain is important to maintain a healthy fish population. Big fish eat little fish, the easier the better. Remember to harvest your fish, this makes room for the others to grow.
