Personal and Salon Updates

It's fair to say that I've been a bit incog-negro of late. I haven't been feeling writing. I've been too engrossed in the continuing saga that is "Democracy Lost: Tales of a Dying Empire." As I reflected on what article I would write for this blog, I thought of how crazy the past few months have been. Within UNC, we passed through the months of August-September with bated breath waiting for our grant authorization notice (GAN) to be received. With the cuts in the Department of Education (DOE), NOTHING is a guarantee, even though we technically have two more years on our cooperative agreement. The notification was received on Sept. 22nd with only one week to spare before we would all be sent home. That notice was definitely a welcome sight! But in early October, we received notification that our DOE project officer has been laid off due to the government shutdown and funding authorization NOT being completed in the manner and timeframe that the GOP has demanded. With this added uncertainty, it is clear that staff morale and government efficiency (for those who remain) is not the highest priority. We regularly encourage each other to press on in the face of so much volatility and inconsistency. It's truly hard to process how quickly a society can take a turn into authoritarianism. Growing up, I was always fascinated by how the atrocities of WWII could come about in a modern era. I have looked out for the signs and "kept my ear to the ground" in an effort to understand. Now, I know viscerally. Meantime as the government is still shutdown, the recessed Congressmen are receiving salaries along with the police state, and air traffic controllers and TSA workers press on with no remuneration.

I think I have become a sucker for punishment, because I listen to C-Span Radio daily. I have grown weary of mainstream media sharing the news AFTER placing their characteristic spin on the story.
