

# Please Flush Responsibly

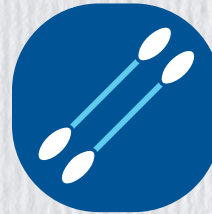

## Don't Flush These Frequent Offenders



### WIPES

Wipes clog pipes! Never flush disposable wipes down the commode even if the packaging says you can.



### HYGIENE PRODUCTS

Dental floss, cotton balls/swabs, and feminine hygiene products should **always** go in the trash.



### CAT LITTER

Human waste belongs in the toilet; cat litter belongs in the garbage can.



### MEDICATION

Once medication is dissolved in water, there's no getting it out. Look for medication drop-off locations or destroy the medication and throw it out.



### PAPER TOWELS

Sturdy paper towels may be tough enough for cleaning, but they are too tough for our pipes. Toss them in the garbage.
