Boardman Arts Park: Delaware County Beer & Wine Festival Boardman Arts Park, Where Community and Creativity Meet

The Delaware County Beer & Wine Festival celebrates 5 years running on Saturday, June 28, 2025 from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM at Boardman Arts Park!

The 5th Annual Delaware County Beer & Wine Festival is sponsored this year by Mix 107.9, Cheshire Crossing Animal Hospital, Leather & Oak Spirits in Hilliard, and Richwood Bank. Visitors can expect over 50 tasting opportunities from different vendors, including beer, wine, cider, mead and whiskey. Non-alcoholic coffee and smoothie tasting options are new to the festival this year! There will also be food trucks, live music, an art market featuring 12+ artisans, and other entertainment.

Food trucks include Aunt Di's Kitchen, The Backstretch Food Truck, Cheesecake Perfection, Holy BBQ, Marion's Panini and Soup Truck, and Tacomania. Two bands will headline the Festival; be sure to catch Yachtopia from 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM and Jessica Flowers and New Bloom from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Festival-goers can also enjoy shopping from the 12+ artisans selling everything from jerky to crochet! The Festival will host a silent auction of Beer & Wine merch and summer items and a 50/50 raffle.

Attendees are in for a special testing treat this year: Whimsy-inspired drinks! The Whimsy Venue will be a 2-acre performance area on Boardman Arts Park's festival field, creating a one-of-a-kind experience for visitors. Plans include an iconic art-forward large stage, updated grounds, and a year-round event house. Seven beverage vendors are paying tribute to the Park's highly anticipated venue: D&D Meadery, Dalton Union Winery & Brewery, Hellbranch Hard Cider, Old Dog Alehouse & Brewery, Plum Run Winery, Rhetoric Brewing Co., and Zen Bee Meadery. Guests are invited to vote for their favorite participant!

Each of the vendors at the Delaware County Beer & Wine Festival will bring multiple varietals for tasting, and wineries will also be selling bottles and cases to take home. Vendors include Bird Dog Whiskey, Coastline Coffee, D&D Meadery, Dalton Union Winery & Brewery, Feisty Brood Meadery, Grove City Brewing Co, Happenstance Brewing Project, Hellbranch Hard Cider, Leather & Oak Spirits, Old Dog Alehouse & Brewery, Open BTL Wine and Spirits, Penelope Bourbon, Plum Run Winery, Rhetoric Brewing Co., Roundhouse Depot Brewing, Sunny Sips, The Fox Winery, Traveling Tom's Coffee Truck, and Zen Bee Meadery.

Tickets are \$20 when purchased in advance, and \$25 at the door (if available). Entry includes six tastes and a commemorative glass. Additional tasting tickets are \$3 or 4 tastings for \$10. Boardman Arts Park is located at 154 West William Street, Delaware.
