Boardman Arts Park is pleased to offer two concerts during the month of July as part of their Performance in the Park series!

On Saturday, July 19, Boardman Arts Park welcomes Hard Day's Night, a Beatles tribute band, to the Whimsy venue! Hard Day's Night is a top rated touring Beatles tribute band. Hailing from the rock & roll city of Cleveland, Ohio, they have been entertaining the masses in America and abroad since 1996. The band has been wowing audiences for years, with their full catalogue performances-wearing stitch-for-stitch costume replications; playing authentic Vox, Hofner, Gretsch, Rickenbacker, and Ludwig instruments, all while playing the songs fans know and love with staggering precision.

"This is a special treat for the Delaware community," says Sharon Hayes, a volunteer with Boardman Arts Park, who has previously traveled to see Hard Day's Night, "Hard Day's Night puts on a great show for both original and new Beatles fans! You can't help but dance and sing along!"

Boardman Arts Park is grateful to RCD RV Supercenter for sponsoring this event. Doors for the Hard Day's Night concert open at 5:00 PM, and the concert begins at 6:30 PM. General admission tickets may be purchased in advance online at <https://givebutter.com/HardDaysNightConcert> for \$15 or at the door for \$20. Children age 12 and under are free. Guests are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs or picnic blankets. There will be food trucks onsite, as well as beer, wine, and seltzer for purchase. No outside food or drink will be allowed in.

The festival also offers additional entertainment including a silent auction, face painting and live caricatures by Fairy Kisses Faces, guitars and ukuleles to try out from Music Royale Music Shop, a Lego play area provided by Bricks and Minifigs, and an "artists alley" with local creators showcasing their handmade goods. There will also be food trucks and drink vendors. Food trucks include Aunt Di's Kitchen, The Backstretch, Ciao Cafe, Hot Leggs, Liberty Kettle Corn and Fruit Smashers, Nudderific Nuts, and Tacomania.

Tickets for the Delaware Music Festival may be purchased in advance online at <https://givebutter.com/c/2025DelawareMusicFestival> for \$8 or \$10 at the door. Tickets at the door for seniors and veterans are \$8, and ages 15 and under may enter the festival for free. This low cost event is made possible with the support of Alum Creek Marina, Firestone Brehm Wolf Whitney & Young LLP, First Commonwealth Bank, Gullett Guitars, MindBridge Integrated Health, and the Ohio Arts Council.

Both the Hard Day's Night concert and the Delaware Music Festival are fundraisers for Boardman Arts Park, a nonprofit organization. Proceeds raised will go toward future development and programming.
