## **Boardman Arts Park: Water Feature Installation Returns to Park!**

### ***Boardman Arts Park, Where Community and Creativity Meet***

A beloved installation has returned to Boardman Arts Park!

“Dripping 88” was first installed in 2023 at Boardman Arts Park in the Imagination Space. This temporary installation transformed the hollowed shell of a baby grand piano into a whimsical art piece complete with cascading water flowing from its frame like a waterfall. It quickly became a favorite place of contemplation in the Park for visitors. Over time, it was shaped by the elements and reached the natural conclusion of its installation period.

In its place, Boardman Arts Park is thrilled to unveil a brand new 3-D printed “Dripping 88” donated fully by Willow Brook Christian Communities. The new piano waterfall has been brought to life by Artalysis of Westerville, Ohio. The 3-D printed nature of the piece has allowed embellishment, including the name of work, to be incorporated directly into the body of the piano. It is based on the look of the original baby grand piano.
