Terms and Conditions

Deposit - A 20% deposit, paid by wire transfer, PayPal or Credit Card payments is required to confirm the booking. For the booking to take effect, Local Moshi Adventures must state in an email to the Client that it has received the deposit. 50% of this deposit is refundable.

Credit Cards - A transaction fee of 3.5% will be added to any PayPal or credit card payments. Alternatively bank to bank wire transfer is available.

Balance - The remaining balance (80%) is due 30 days prior to trip begin.

Refund - If Client cancels trip between 7 and 29 days of trip begin a 80% refund will be issued. If Client cancels trip between 1 and 7 days a 70% refund will be issued.

- Postponement to any future date is available until December 31st, 2023, at no additional cost.

- If the trip is postponed to 2024 and Tanzania Park fees are increased, Client will be responsible for the fee difference. If Tanzania Park fees remain the same there will be no additional fee.

Trip Cancellations - Trip cancellations must be made in writing and acknowledged by Local Moshi Adventures.

Trip Interruptions - If the Client leaves the trip - voluntarily or involuntarily - under any circumstance after the trip has begun, any additional cost incurred due to such actions is the responsibility of the Client. There are no refunds for services not utilized.

Liability Waiver - For the climb/safari to depart a signed liability waiver must be received by Local Moshi Adventures.

Insurance - Medical travel insurance covering high altitude trekking is a requirement to participate in our climbs.

Booking - By making a booking, Client accepts and is bound by these Terms and Conditions.

A booking is accepted and becomes definite only when the Company sends an email explicitly stating that the trip is confirmed.

Thank you for choosing to climb responsibly with a KPAP partner company.

The exploitation and mistreatment of porters can be a troubling challenge in the climbing industry.

Therefore, Local Moshi Adventures is proud to be a partner of KPAP (Kilimanjaro Porters Assistance Project), a Tanzanian non-for-profit organization and initiative of IMEC (International Mountain Explorers Connection), overseeing the fair and ethical treatment of porters and mountain crews.

By being a KPAP partner we volunteer that every climb of ours will be monitored by a KPAP investigative porter to ensure we are adhering to KPAP guidelines, which include guaranteed minimum salary, salaries being paid within 2 days, porter loads do not exceed 20 kg, 3 meals a day, proper shelter and clothing, proper care for sick or injured porters, a fair and transparent tipping procedure.

While tipping is not common practice in many countries and cultures around the world, tipping for good service on Kilimanjaro, and Tanzania in general, is customary and expected. Thus, your mountain crew may expect (though never demand) a tip from your group at the end of the climb.

Suggested tipping amounts depend on climb length and crew size, and crew size depends on the amenities requested by climbers. For example, a toilet tent or personal oxygen require an additional porter for each. Local Moshi Adventures will provide crew member information once the details of the climb have been determined.
