ROOM MOM PACKET - ONE PER CLASS - PICK UP BACKSTAGE AT THE SHOWS

- Packets contain Sign-in/out Sheets and Badges.
- Packet will go to the first Room Mom who picks it up.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **You will report backstage** to your assigned dressing room to greet your dancers and their parents.
2. **Parents will “sign in”** their child and help them with their costume and accessories.
3. **NO FATHERS, UNCLES, GRANDPAS OR BROTHERS IN THE GIRLS’ DRESSING ROOMS.**
4. **You will remain in the dressing room**, watching the class until it is their time to perform. Dancers are not allowed to leave the dressing room without their parents.
5. **Depending on your age group, you may have to assist dancers to the bathrooms** or you may need to assist them into other costumes. You are responsible for making sure dancers are presentable for stage with their hair, make-up and accessories in their proper places.
6. **A backstage coordinator will take you and your class backstage.** They have stage charts and will be responsible for placing dancers in their correct order.
7. **You will watch the performance up close**, in the wings, backstage.
8. **You will take your dancers back to the dressing room** and remain with them until it is time to line up for the finale.
9. **A backstage coordinator will line up your students** for the finale. You will stay backstage while dancers are on stage.
10. **After they bow, student helpers will assist your class** off the stage and bring them back into the dressing room.
11. **ROOM MOMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DANCERS UNTIL THEIR PARENT SIGNS THEM OUT.**
12. **Parents will arrive to the dressing rooms. They must “sign out” their dancer.** They will help their child out of their costume.
13. **You must remain in the dressing room** until all of your dancers have been picked up.
14. **Turn in badges and sign in/out sheets** to a backstage Take Five Dance Staff member.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pick-up Production T-Shirts at the Shows

Volunteers (Ushers/Ticket Checkers) will borrow a Take Five Dance Production black t-shirt. You will be able to pick up your shirt from the Take Five Box Office in the high school lobby on the day you are volunteering.

2. Clean Up - ALL VOLUNTEERS

Please help clean up the seats, rows, and aisles once the performance is over. This is a quick process since water bottles are the only thing allowed in the theatre.

3. Digital Program Book

Volunteers will help explain the digital program book to guests. We will have posters with the QR Code to download/view the program book and guests will also be able to view the program book from our website at TakeFiveDance.com.

4. Ushers

Ushers will be posted in certain areas in the audience. You are responsible for “keeping the calm” in the audience. We have assigned a “Lead Usher” to explain specific duties. This will take place once everyone has arrived. Ushers might wear headsets and carry flashlights.

5. Ticket Checkers

Ticket Checkers will be posted in the Lobby. Please greet our guests with smiles, “hellos” and “welcomes.” Make sure tickets are for the correct show. *You may also be asked to be an Usher.*
