1.	The full paper should not be more than fifteen pages.	
2.	The first line should bear the title of the paper in bold capital letters, Centered, and in Times

3.	After the title of the paper, follows the name of the and author/s.	
4.	After the names are the designation, department and organization or agency	
5.	It shall be followed by the complete organization address.	
6.	Next part is the abstract (not more than 250 words) in bold, italic font with not less 5 keywords	
7.	The parts of the papers should be the following:	
	a. Introduction;	
	b. Statement of the Problems/Objectives;	
	c. Review of Literature	
	c. Methodology;	
	d. Findings;	
	e. Conclusion;	
	f. Recommendation;	
	g. Short Acknowledgment; and,	
	h References.
