

Highlights from this year's annual board and general meetings.

The annual board and general meetings for the NDQHRA were held on November 11th, 2018 at the Baymont Inn and Suites in Mandan ND.

The 2019 NDQHRA races will be held in the same locations as last season. ND Certified Bred Futurity and Derby will be at the ND Horse Park in Fargo, ND and the Northern Plains Futurity and ND Certified Bred Maturity will be at Chippewa Downs in Belcourt, ND.

Rules reiterated: 1. If your horse is must wear a flipping rig, you enter it at your own risk. 2. If the gate malfunctions due to a horse crashing through it, the horse is considered a nonstarter. 3. There are 8 horses per race – if there are more than 3 trials then the final 2 entries for the final race will be determined by shaking/or drawing.

Wes Heinert discussed the Historic Racing bill and it was agreed that the NDQHRA group would join in trying to get it passed. Plans are to hire a lobbyist to assist in passing the bill. There will be a raffle held to help with funding.

Reminder: membership in the NDQHRA is a privilege not a right. When the racing steward and racing commission leaves a purse and/or race decision up to the NDQHRA Board the board members are polled, and their decision is final.

An election was held to replace 2 board members whose terms were up: Wes Heinert and Doug Plummer. They were re-elected.

The auction ends on January 31st, 2019 at 6:00 PM CDST. For those stallions that did not sell but can continue in the auction, they will be sold on a first come first serve basis. After January 31st, if you make a bid and it meets a minimum requirement, it will automatically be sold to you.

Note that anyone who bids but does not pay for their bid is black balled from future auctions and legal action may be taken to collect payment. Thank you for your continued support in this fundraiser.

To make a nomination, please complete and return the following form.

If you wish to be considered for a year-end award, please submit the nomination form with the name of your horse, amount earned, and proof of earnings by AQHA records, to the NDQHRA. You may attach a separate sheet with this information. To be eligible, the following criteria must be met.

- Points will be awarded for each dollar earned from a recognized track.
- ND Bred horses will earn points the entire racing season provided the owner is a member of the NDQHRA.
- ND owned horses will earn points during the period the horse is registered in a ND residence name, and the owner is a member of the NDQHRA.
- Only paid 2018 members of NDQHRA may submit nominees.
- Please use an official source for proof of race earnings such as Equibase (Equibase.com) or True Form Racing Services (/racewithtrs.com).

Please read the following terms and check a response to each question. **Thank you** for your donation and continued support of our organization!

- I will donate the listed stallion season(s) to the NDQHRA for their 2019 Stallion Season Service Auction. I understand all foals sired by the donated stallion will be eligible to run in the 2022 Northern Plains Futurity and the season must sell for the stallion to be eligible.
- Location of the 2022 Northern Plains Race is TBA.
- If the season fails to sell by January 31st, 2019: **I WILL** **or WILL NOT** **allow the NDQHRA to hold the season out for 30 days**, at a minimum bid of \$300 (or as indicated by the donor.) Stallion seasons will be sold on a first come first serve basis during these 30 days.
- If the season fails to sell, the stallion owner or farm may purchase the stallion for **\$300** to keep future foals eligible. The stallion owner has 60 days from the close of the auction to purchase the season back.
- I understand that as donor, I reserve the right to bid on my own behalf.
- If the breeder fails to get a live foal, **a return breeding IS** **or IS NOT** offered. If offered, a return breeding is limited to one year. If the first mare fails to conceive, the stallion owner must approve any substitute mare.
- **The bidding will start at \$300** (unless a minimum bid is specified by the donor) and the stallion service must sell to qualify foals as eligible.
