CSR Highlights (2022–2025)

Over the past three years, Purecotz Eco Lifestyles Pvt. Ltd. has undertaken a series of CSR initiatives focused on water conservation, afforestation, sustainable waste management, and education support. These projects reflect our long-term vision of building resilient communities, empowering youth, and protecting the environment.

Year-wise Initiatives

2022-2023

International Society for Krishna Consciousness – Govardhan Eco Village

- Strengthened the **rainwater harvesting pond**, ensuring storage of **80+ lakh litres** of additional water.
- Benefits: Dual purpose of **groundwater recharge** and **surface water storage**, supporting **Govardhan Eco Village** residents and nearby farmers.
- Impact: Secured water sustainability and reduced water stress in the region.









2023-2024

Afforestation Project - Sarai

- 5,000 saplings planted across 38 native species.
- Area covered: 4 acres (~2,200 sq. metres).
- Carbon sequestration potential: ~20 kg CO₂ absorbed per tree annually = 125,000 kg (100 tonnes) CO₂ offset/year.
- Contribution: Enhancing biodiversity, improving air quality, and building ecological resilience through Purecotz's first forest creation CSR project.







Afforestation Project - Tadegaon

- 3,600 saplings planted across 42 native species using the Miyawaki method.
- Area covered: 2 acres.
- Carbon sequestration potential: 25 kg CO₂ absorbed per tree annually = **90,000 kg** CO₂ offset/year.
- Contribution: Restoration of biodiversity, soil enrichment, and creation of a dense, self-sustaining green cover.

Total carbon dioxide sequestered per year from the project is 215 tonnes







2024-2025

Partnership with Auxilium Convent Schools & Sahayini Social Development Society

1. Student Support:

 Distributed 200 writing pads and 400 pencils to underprivileged students at Auxilium Convent School, Wadala, Mumbai.

2. Eco-Friendly Infrastructure Donations:

- o **RGGC-L Bio composting machines:** Installed at schools in Wadala (Mumbai), Vadodara (Gujarat), Panjim (Goa), Benaulim (Goa), Maral, and others.
- o **Garden benches & waste bins:** Donated to schools in Mumbai and Lonavala to encourage outdoor learning and waste segregation.

3. Training & Monitoring by RUR Greenlife:

- Staff training and student awareness sessions conducted to ensure sustainable operations of composting machines.
- Online demonstrations and follow-up monitoring ensured long-term efficiency.

Impact Metrics (Auxilium Schools & Partner Institutions):

Wet waste recycled annually: **8,736 kg (2024–25)** Compost generated annually: **4,368 kg**

Methane mitigated annually: 1,747.2 kg

CO₂ emissions mitigated annually: 2.62 tons

Direct beneficiaries: 500 students & teachers

Water Conservation

• 80+ lakh litres harvested, securing groundwater recharge and surface water storage for community and farmers.

Afforestation

- 8,600 trees planted across 80 native species (Sarai & Tadegaon projects).
- Carbon sequestration potential: ~215 tonnes of CO₂ absorbed annually.
- Contributions: Biodiversity restoration, air quality improvement, soil enrichment, and climate resilience.

Waste Management & Sustainability

- 45,000+ kg wet waste recycled annually.
- ~10,000 kg compost generated annually.
- ~9 tonnes CO₂ mitigated annually (methane + emissions reduction).

Education & Social Impact

- 1,300+ students and teachers directly engaged in sustainability programs.
- Essential school supplies distributed to underprivileged students, fostering access to education.
- Eco-infrastructure (composting machines, benches, waste bins) installed at schools across Mumbai, Goa, Gujarat, and Maharashtra.
