GUIDELINES FOR RESUMING BASEBALL ACTIVITIES

WRBSA players, coaches, volunteers and parents have read and agree to follow Idaho State protocols outlined in “Idaho Rebounds Stages 1-4”. This includes but is not limited to:

1. Players, coaches, volunteers and parents are not allowed to show up to practice or games if they are not feeling well, or if someone in their home has been currently confirmed to have COVID-19.
2. Any players, coaches, volunteers or parents that have been exposed to someone who currently has COVID-19 must remain away from any WRBSA activities for 14 days.
3. If any family member of a player, coach, volunteer or parent contracts COVID-19, WRBSA is to be informed **immediately**.
4. Coaches, volunteers and representatives of WRBSA will NOT attend any WRBSA practices or games if they have any symptoms of COVID-19.
5. All balls and practice bats will be disinfected after each use. All porta-potties will be cleaned/disinfected after each practice/game. Hand washing stations will be provided by WRBSA.
6. Players can **only** use their own equipment besides balls and bases. This includes but is not limited to, batting gloves, baseball gloves, bats, cleats, clothing, glasses, hats, helmets and water bottles. No sharing of snacks, drinks, sunflower seeds and gum is allowed. **Parents are advised to provide your player with a spray bottle of sanitizer to spray all personal equipment before and after each practice/game.**
7. No Physical Contact of any kind is allowed between players, coaches, volunteers and parents, including high-fives or fist bumps until Stage 4 is complete (on or about June 26) and physical contact is **not recommended** by WRBSA after that.
8. Face coverings are **mandatory** until Idaho reaches Stage 4 (June 13-26) and **recommended** after that.
9. WRBSA will not have more people on a field at one time and maintain the recommended social distance of six (6) feet between people, as recommended by the protocols outlined in “Idaho Rebounds Stages 1-4.” Stage 1 is no group gatherings; Stage 2 is groups of less than 10 people; Stage 3 is groups of 10-50 people; and Stage 4 is more than 50 people.

IF ANY PLAYER, COACH, VOLUNTEER OR PARENT DOES NOT FOLLOW PROTOCOLS, HE/SHE WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM WRBSA ACTIVITIES UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
