Hiring new employees was discussed. Owen to write up job descriptions as discussed and begin advertising.

Temporary job assignment updates were given. All members have been keeping up on the assignments.

Volunteer tree removal pay was discussed. Motion by O Neill second of Larson to pay Dave Fuller \$500 and Nathan Singrey \$250 for assisting the town to remove trees from the storm.
