



Greetings UPrep Parents,

The RCSD announced their plans to begin the 20-21 school year fully remote/virtual for the first marking period which is the first 10 weeks of school. Originally UPREP would remain remote/virtual for the first five weeks of school and then begin a hybrid model. The RCSD model would have an adverse effect on us to begin the hybrid model out of alignment with them as it relates to special education staff, nursing, and transportation services that are provided by them. To ensure the safety and consistency with Uprep we believe it is in our best interest to remain fully remote/virtual for the first marking period along with the RCSD. We will still begin on 9/14/2020 and remain remote/virtual until 11/16/2020. We will re-evaluate moving to hybrid as we get closer to the end of the marking period. The decision will be based on recommendation from Monroe County Health Department, SUNY, and Department of Education in its regards. This communication will be going out to the families via robo call/email and we will have it on the school website. We have also set up a parent zoom meeting for 8/27/2020 to address any questions they may have. Thank you in advance for your support as we continue to navigate through these new normals together.
