## Craignarget Cottage, Auchenmalg, Glenluce, Newton Stewart Wigtownshire DG8 0JU



Craignarget Cottages have been in the ownership

of our family for over 50 years. When first purchased in 1963, neither cottage had electricity or water and cottage No. 2, (your accommodation), had a sitting tenant. Miss Hislop collected her water from the well which can still be seen over the wall about 100m



up the road from the cottage. She had been in the service of the previous owners who farmed much of the local land, and lived out her retirement in the cottage. She cut the front lawn on her hands and knees with a pair of scissors! On her death in 1965, cottage No. 2 was renovated and extended by the addition of a bathroom.

The cottage is located on the A747, mid way between Glenluce and Port William, with a small lawn between the cottage and the road. Traffic is

generally light, with busier times morning and evening as might be expected. The beach is immediately adjacent to the road and is shingle on the upper part with a large expanse of

firm sand and rock pools at low tide. Herons as well as many different sea birds frequent the rock pools and otters are becoming an increasingly common sight on the beach in recent years. Deer can often be seen in the adjacent field in the early morning and ravens, falcons and harriers can sometimes be seen soaring the hill.



The proximity of the sea is one of the most appealing aspects of Craignarget Cottage. The beach is always
