This month, 17 Grace members will be traveling to San Juan, Puerto Rico for our first intergenerational mission trip. Our group includes 5 children/youth and 12 adults. As you know, much of Puerto Rico was devastated by Hurricane Maria in September 2017, and recovery efforts still continue. Some of the projects we'll be

working on include native tree planting, maintenance of ecological gardens, tree removal at the Bible Camp, construction, and church clean-up.





## Outreach Committee

Every Monday morning a group of women shows up in the fellowship hall to create beautiful tied quilts for Lutheran World Relief (LWR) and lap robes for members who are home-bound. No one can remember when the group first started, but this activity has probably been going on for well over thirty years. Stop by the church about 10:00 on most Mondays, and you will see them busy at work: cutting fabric, sewing, and tying quilt pieces together.

The women set a goal to increase the number of quilts by at least one each year. Since 2011, they have made about 600 quilts and 30 lap robes! This is definitely a labor of love and outreach.




I am looking forward to planning out another amazing GLOW year for our middle schoolers and launching our new High School program this fall!

## Lutherdale Update

On Sunday, March 3, Craig and Jennifer Hellberg represented Grace Lutheran at the Lutherdale Bible Camp Annual Meeting. Lutherdale Bible Camp, located in Elkhorn, WI, served over 10,000 people in 2018. The meeting started with opening devotions and then moved into routine meeting activities including review of previous meeting minutes, financial report, staff reports, welcoming of new staff and board elections. There is a lot of exciting work going on at Lutherdale including the Youth Bible Camp programs many of our Grace Lutheran children attend, the growing 50 Forward program and construction of the Lutherdale Lodge.

Youth programs continue to be a central focus of Lutherdale with over 2,000 campers served in 2018. If you are interested in learning more, you can visit the open house on June 2 from 1-4p or ask around – many of our children at Grace have attended their summer camps and winter retreats week-ends. Early registration discounts are available if you register before June 5<sup>th</sup>.

If your current place in life does not include interest in youth programs, you may be interested in the 50 Forward program. Lutherdale is offering a growing number of events to more senior campers including a chance to revisit camp through Silver Campers days, Honey Harvest learning about Lutherdale's very own honey production, Christmas Cookie tour of Milwaukee bakeries and others.

The most exciting news at Lutherdale is the construction of the Lutherdale Lodge. This is a massive project for Lutherdale - \$2.9 million capital goal, with \$2.6 million already pledged. The Lodge, expected to open in 2020, will have 20 hotel style guest rooms, a 130-seat conference room, hospitality center and board room for smaller meetings. The 20,000 sq ft facility will be located across from the Dining Hall on the Lutherdale property. The Lodge is being constructed by Mission Builders, a mission based organization of retired trade professionals that offer services at a reduced cost. There are also many opportunities to support this effort through volunteering. Contact Sara Jonasen, Campaign Manager, at [sara@lutherdale.org](mailto:sara@lutherdale.org) for more information.

Grace Lutheran is one of 96 churches in the southern Wisconsin/Northern Illinois area that financially supports Lutherdale. These churches provide ~8% of the funding annually with another 8% coming from individual gifts, some of which are from our members and 72% from programs, many of which we participate in. You can help through direct donation, volunteering, attending one of the many events such as Dinners at the Lake or the annual Quilt Auction (August 10<sup>th</sup>) or sponsoring a square for the Quilt Garden. **May 14, 2019**

Meeting called to order by President Steve Geis at 7:05pm

## **Action Items:**

**Devotions** – Amanda Kosanda and Tim Neuenschwander; No Agenda changes **Sponsorship request** from Hailee Sundquist to be invited to share her request with the congregation and an item will be added for her in the bulletin. Financial Committee to submit a proposal for setting up a scholarship fund for the future. April meeting minutes approved unanimously via email. Motion to approve reports by Amy Simdon, seconded by Jean Scott, Approved unanimously.

**Synod Assembly recap** -Pastor Jennifer: Workshop, Banquet and Elections New this year was a "Backpack" (food) program. Attendees created 1,000 backpacks. Motion by Lori Jensen, seconded by Amanda Kosanda, approved unanimously to send the typical Synod offering to the backpack program.

**Property report recap** –Bryan Holmen 3 new trees have been planted, Removed bushes contributing to drainage issues, Drivers for mowing are needed., Boilers passed inspection and have been recertified.

**Treasury Report - Tim Neuenschwander** Revenue up 9% this month for the general fund. Special giving up 141% (Increase attributed to the bingo fundraiser, the Easter breakfast and other giving related to the mission trip, Easter and camp fundraising. Expenses up 43% this month (attributed to the mission trip, offset by fundraising). Operating at a deficit (\$1,918.12). Total revenue is down compared to 2018.

The Finance Council held its April and May meetings since the last council meeting.

- ◆ Dawn Spaanem was appointed to serve as Internal Audit for the committee.
- ◆ April Mickelson will serve as representative from the collection counters.

There is the need to install procedures and processes for handling collection count.

Currently no framework in place and no training for new counters.

- ◆ Insurance Policies are being reviewed for potential cost savings, to understand coverages and identify potential liabilities, if any.
- ◆ Expecting decreased donations in 2019 related to recent tax changes. Planning to pursue a tax planning seminar for members in September to help congregation understand how to save money and help church.
- ◆ Finance Committee to check with local vendors on a better means and/or restriction on local lines of credit.

**Pastor's report:** 3 Funerals, Jackie and Pastor Jennifer to attend a Youth Ministry Program-Synod Program May 21<sup>st</sup>; Brat stand May 25<sup>th</sup> (likely the last fund raiser for the Puerto Rico mission trip). Starting a book study for the book "Educated".

**Old Business:** Beam repair is being pursued and communion rail is in progress.

**Next meeting: June 11 at 7:00 p.m. at Grace**

Motion by Erik Olsen, seconded by Amanda Kosanda to adjourn at 8:15 p.m. Motion carried unanimously, followed by the Lord's Prayer.




Pastor Jennifer got super creative this year with her Children's Sermons, from treasure hunts to science experiments, the sermon message came alive for young and old!
