AGE CLASSES (weight classes will be determined day of tournament): The age of the wrestlers will be determined as of January 1, 2026, Ages 4U; Ages 6U; Ages 8U; Ages 10U; Ages 12U; Ages 14U; Ages 14U Girls, Girls K-2 and 3-5

PVJW Reserves the right to perform random weight checks and verify ages with proof of birth certificate.

BRACKETING: 4-6 man round robin brackets will be used.

AWARDS: 1ST, 2ND, 3RD, 4TH place Medals, Coach Award, Team Awards, Referee Award (handed out between sessions)

RULES: PVJW is adopting the recent wrestling rule changes, primarily adopted by the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS). Further details: 1. Ages 4 through 10 years will wrestle 3 one minute periods. 2. Ages 11 through 14 will wrestle 3 one and one half minute periods. 3. Ties will be broken with a one minute overtime period with both wrestlers on their feet. The first take down wins.
