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Faces Kids Club Pre-school and out of school care was established in 1998 and now operate out of the previous school building on Sawyers Hall Lane in Brentwood, adjacent to Becket Keys and Grove house school.

Our home from home environment provides outstanding care for children aged between 3 and 12 years old. Our breakfast, after school and holiday clubs provide a perfect balance between entertainment and relaxation. Our Pre-school work to the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Boys and girls can join Faces Kids Club at any age and at any time of the year. We are open to children from all over the world and from all cultural, ethnic and religious backgrounds.

Although we have grown to over 200 children on-roll, we remain a small, family-sized school offering with unique benefits, including a friendly, caring and safe environment with zero tolerance to bullying and our method of care ensures the children always feel happy to attend.

2. Faces Pre-School

At **Faces Kids Club** Pre-School we believe that “every child is a unique child who is constantly learning”.

We aim to make each child’s early education experiences positive and meaningful.

We know that children learn best in a welcoming, warm, secure and caring environment, where they are able to experiment, have fun, take risks, learn from their experiences and grow in confidence. The unique character and individuality of each child is encouraged and valued.

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework.

Children in the EYFS learn by playing and exploring, being active, and through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outside. This means your child will be learning skills, acquiring new knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through 7 areas of learning and development.

The 7 areas of learning are communication and language, physical development, personal, social and emotional development, literacy, mathematics, understanding the world and expressive arts and design.

Every day we provide if required a nutritionally balanced lunch cooked on the premises. We carry a 5 star food hygiene rating.

We use an online interactive journal platform to share children’s progress through the EYFS. Parents can log in remotely at any time to see how their child is progressing.

3. Faces Holiday Club

Faces Kids Club Holiday Club operates throughout each half term, for the duration of the whole six weeks holiday and INSET days during the hours of 8.30am - 6pm.

Children are required to bring their own lunch, all activities are provided for ensuring their precious holiday time is made to be as memorable and fun as possible.

Faces Kids Club have exceptional facilities including a full size gymnasium and self enclosed gardens, providing the perfect setting to meet every child's interest.

Faces Kids Club provide children with the perfect balance between unwinding and recharging their batteries and keeping them busily entertained.

Activities are planned to help children receive a balance of physical, intellectual, social and spiritual guidance through play.

We carry a 5 star food hygiene rating, our staff are trained in food hygiene. All our food is purchased from the local Sainsbury's. Where possible we use seasonal, organic fruit and vegetables.

4. Breakfast Club

Faces Kids Club Breakfast Club operates every morning during term-time between 7:00am and 9:00am. Children are welcomed into a friendly environment where they are free to play before being taken safely to school.

Children are offered breakfast which is a choice of cereal, porridge or toast with toppings. We always use organic food wherever possible. All children have access to filtered water.

The children are given the choice to play, read, do homework or simply relax before their school day begins.

Each morning we diffuse rosemary essential oils in the club, this is proven to help children become ready and alert for the day ahead.

We carry a 5 star food hygiene rating, our staff are trained in food hygiene. All our food is purchased from the local Sainsbury's. Where possible we use seasonal, organic fruit and vegetables.

5. After School Club

Faces Kids Club After School Club operates every afternoon during term-time between 3:00pm and 6:00pm. Children are escorted safely back to Faces where they are free to play.

All the children are offered a light evening tea. All food is freshly prepared on site and are nutritionally balanced. Organic fruit and veg is used wherever possible.

The children are given the choice to either continue to play or join in with one of the planned activities until their parents or carers collect them.

Faces Kids Club have exceptional facilities including a full size gymnasium, self enclosed gardens, quiet reading areas and lots more, this helps to provide the perfect setting to meet every child's interest.

Each afternoon we diffuse lavender essential oils throughout the club, this helps children relax and unwind after school.

We carry a 5 star food hygiene rating, our staff are trained in food hygiene. All our food is purchased from the local Sainsbury's. Where possible we use seasonal, organic fruit and vegetables.

6. Nutrition

At Faces Kids Club we believe healthy eating can stabilise children's energy and promote learning and play.

Our chefs provide a diverse menu of balanced and nutritious meals which we believe encourages healthy eating habits and influences the child's long term relationship with food. All our food is bought from our local Sainsbury's and wherever possible we use seasonal organic fruit and vegetables.

We will work alongside parents to ensure the meals meet individual requirements

Mealtimes at our setting is fun and educational. We try to replicate the family environment and encourage the children to set the table, share and serve food and develop fine motor skills by cutting fruit and vegetables and using cutlery.



7. Essential oils

At Faces Kids Club we believe in promoting growth using natural health care.

We defuse rosemary throughout our club in the mornings. Studies have shown it helps children and adults improve memory and alertness, helping both children and staff prepare for their coming day ahead.

In contrast we defuse lavender throughout the club through out the afternoon. Studies have shown lavender helps to calm and relax after a long day at school or work.

We only use essential oils that are certified pure grade.

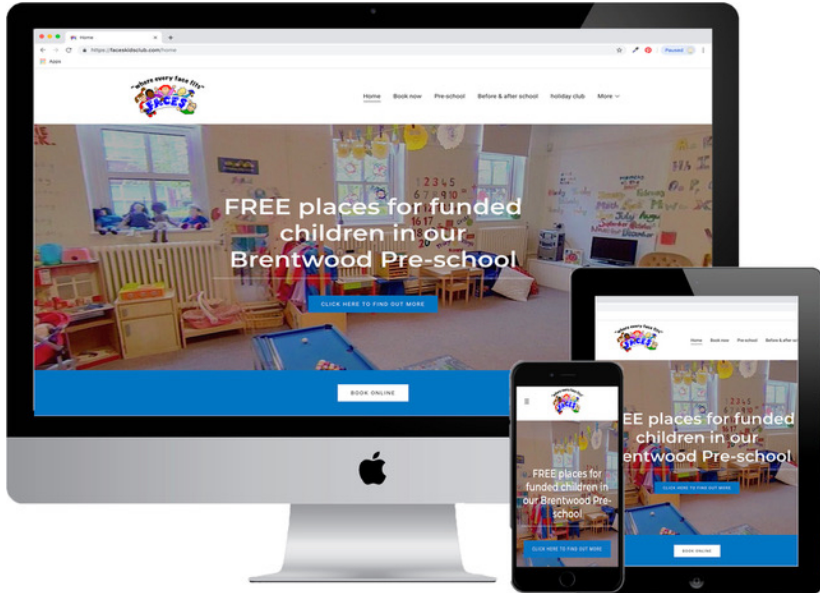

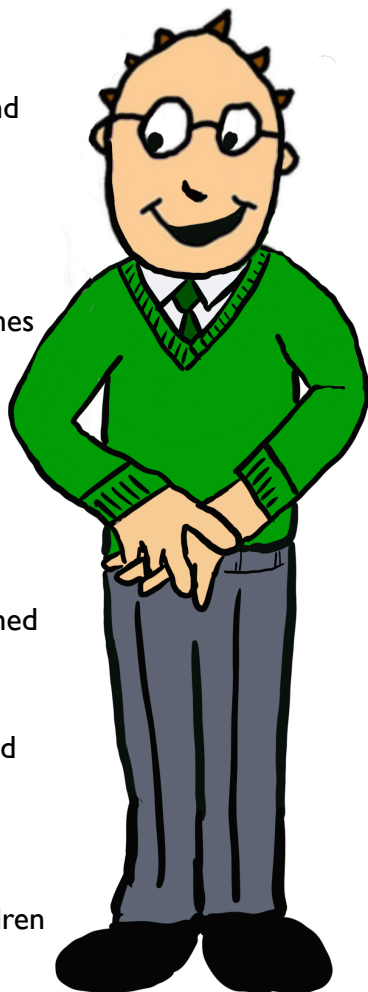


10. Covid 19 update

The welfare and safety of our staff and children is paramount to us. Our team have completed a COVID Risk Assessment and are doing all we can to ensure our club is COVID Secure.

Below is a list of some of the measure we have put in place.

- Social distancing signs
- Regular and thorough hand washing prompts and child friendly signs
- 20 second hand washing timers in toilets
- Team member temperature check
- Increased number of hand sanitise stations
- Staff and child bubbles in line with GOV guidelines
- Increased number of tissues & bins
- New activities suitable for bubbles
- Food preparation sneeze screens
- Escorted child collection and drop helping to minimise contact and increase protection
- Coloured wrist band and coned bubble areas
- Team to focus on sanitising the frequently touched areas
- More regular and enhanced cleaning schedules
