- Box Stock -

Kit must be assembled per the instructions without any additional customization or parts not supplied by the kit. Paint color can be different than box art or instructions. Smoothing of seams - removal of flash for fit and finish is acceptable. Instructions must be provided for judges.

-Custom-

As the word describes, any kit assembled with parts not supplied in the box. After-market items - additions - deletions and kit-bashing allowed.

-Theme Build-

Build a replica of your favorite movie car. A reference picture is not required but suggested.

All entries will be judged by a panel. Each judge will score the entry on a points based system. Best of show will be chosen from the top scoring entries.

All entries must be registered by noon on Saturday of the show. A Club Member will assist with registration and placing kit at the show tent.

HOBBY KNIFE
Use a sharp hobby knife to remove parts from the trees. The knife may also be used to remove parting lines and flash.

FREEZERS
Use small parts freezing and painting when applying compounds.

BUILDING TIPS FOR THE ADVANCED MODELER

For the best possible finish, your kit should be painted, even if molded in color. Paint should be applied evenly, in several thin coats rather than one heavy coat. The first coat should not completely cover the surface. Each layer should be allowed to dry thoroughly before the next is applied. Also, each coat should be "wet sanded" except for the first coat. Use a fine sandpaper (400 grit) to lightly damp. Be careful not to remove any detail while sanding. Wash parts thoroughly before painting. Use a brush to apply liquid paint.
