So, what happens when two objects with momentum collide? It's called collision (not collusion).

"A collision is the event in which two or more bodies exert forces on each other in a relatively short time... Collision usually refers to incidents in which two or more objects collide with great force...."

According to the "coefficient of restitution", there are two special cases of any collision:

1. A perfectly elastic collision is one in which there is no loss of kinetic energy.

2. An inelastic collision is one in which part of the kinetic energy is changed to some other form of energy in the collision.

In a perfectly inelastic collision, i.e., a zero coefficient of restitution, the colliding particles coalesce and the object with the greater momentum overtakes the other, it looks like <u>this</u>.

House Democrats have delayed a planned markup of H.R. 6, the Dream and Promise Act. Although 229 Democrats have already co-sponsored H.R. 6, Democrats on the House Judiciary Committee delayed the hearing over an internal debate about whether to weaken the bill. Demand they stay strong, and **pass the bill** now without watering it down!

Trump asked for **supplemental funding with an additional \$4.5 billion for immigration enforcement --** money that will be used to militarize the border and criminalize, detain, and deport even more immigrants. **Call or MoCs and ask them to reject this request** for more funds for DHS and ICE. Trump has nominated Barry Myers to lead the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). Barry Myers, former CEO of AccuWeather, Inc., lacks scientific expertise and is known to have led a culture of sexual harassment and intimidation against female employees (are we surprised??). Myers also has a long history of trying to privatize the National Weather Service to help his bottom line. The Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation sent Myers's nomination to the full Senate for a vote without a committee hearing, call our Senators and tell them to OPPOSE Barry Myers for Head of the NOAA.
