Recycling offers a wide range of environmental and economic benefits for residents, businesses, and the Commonwealth.

Energy and resources are conserved:

Using existing materials to make new products means less deforestation, fewer damaging mines, and energy saved. Recycling aluminum cans consumes 95% less energy than creating new cans from raw materials.\*

Job Creation:

The Recycling Marketplace directly employed 66,000+ people in Pennsylvania and stimulated almost 110,000 indirect and induced jobs.\*\*

## RECYCLING TIPS



- **Glass - Rinse (No need to remove labels or lids).**  
*(Do Not include light bulbs, dishes, glassware, window or auto glass in bin.)*
- **Metal - aluminum, steel cans and bi-metal cans.**  
*(Do Not include metal hangers, cooking pots and pans or other scrap metals)*
- **Paper - ensure confidential information is not on paper you put in bins.** Please keep dry!
- **Plastics -Rinse; no need to remove labels or lids.**
