

2026 Wilson Harbor Invitational 1K A DAY

1 K a Day

The object of this event is to be the one to weigh the heaviest salmon each day. The event runs over a 7-day period. A 17-pound minimum salmon is required and if no fish over 17-pound is weighed by close of scales of that day, then that day will carry over until there is a daily winner.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Canadian entries are permitted and will be received at Par.
2. Only salmon will be eligible for the 1 K a Day.
3. This tournament is open to any anglers fishing New York waters or Canadian waters of Lake Ontario during the designated dates. The 1K A Day is Not exclusive to WHI teams.
4. Cheating and tampering will not be tolerated in any way. Teams or individuals suspected of cheating or tampering will be disqualified, turned over to the proper authorities for questioning for possible prosecution, or required to pass a lie detector test. Lie detector tests may be given Saturday and/or Sunday. If a team is called to complete a lie detector test, a team member must make themselves available one of those days or face disqualification.
5. If no 17-pound fish are weighed in that day, then the prize will roll over to the following day.
6. Entry ticket stays with the boat. If fishing multiple vessels each vessel must carry its own ticket (entry). Fish caught on any vessel not specified on entry ticket cannot be counted.
7. Weigh stations: 9am to 6pm at the Gas Shack; Wilson, NY, The Boat Doctor's; Olcott, NY and the Wicked worm; Youngstown, NY. *Friday Weigh-in deadline will be 4:00 pm.
8. **All fish to be weighed, must be weighed the same day they are caught**, no exceptions. Carry over fish from the previous day will be disqualified. Weigh stations will remain open between the hours of 9am and 6pm. *Except the Friday before WHI event. Weigh-in deadline will be 4:00 pm.
9. **All fish must meet a 17-pound minimum** weight requirement to qualify.
10. All waters of Lake Ontario will be eligible.
11. All NYS DEC and OMNR rules will be in effect.
12. In the event of a tie score the team first to weigh in will be declared the winner of the daily or weekly prize.
13. **It is required that all fish entered are caught aboard the registered boat.**
14. Rules may be subject to change before start of event.
15. Teams can have any number of members. **It is required that all fish entered are caught aboard the registered boat.**
16. Entry for this tournament will be \$150 per boat with a 10% administration fee. WHI registered teams are **NOT** automatically entered in this event.
17. The intent is to pay out at the WHI Captain's meeting. However, any team suspected or reported to have committed a rule violation, will be asked to take and pass a lie detector test on Sunday afternoon. Monies will be held until then.
