# **Monthly Refreshment Committee 2025**

Each member serves on a service committee one month a year. If you are unable to make your month, please find a substitute or contribute \$25 towards the lunch and contact the Committee Chair.

The Committee Chair is the lead and must contact the members of the committee who have signed up. The Chairperson can be determined the month prior. The Committee for the next month can meet after the general meeting to decide on the theme and type of menu, or the Chairperson can decide and let the committee members know what to bring. Plan light snacks and dessert for 60-70 people.

#### Set up:

- 1. Tables and chairs are set up the day before by the cleaning crew, and cabinets will be opened the day of the meeting for access to supplies.
- 2. Set up can begin at 10:30am the day of or committees may choose to set up the prior day.
- 3. Themes are optional.
- 4. Various centerpiece decorations are available for use and are located in the closet by the ladies' restroom.
- 5. Set up a food table, dessert table and drinks. Service is buffet style.

#### Clean up:

- 1. Please do not start cleaning up until the speaker/program is finished
- 2. Wash and dry any club dishes and put them away in the proper cabinet.
- 3. Return decorations to the women's restroom cabinet.
- 4. Sweep floors with a large broom when needed.
- 5. Take trash out to the back of the building to the large cans.
- 6. Leave tables and chairs standing.

All committee members are required to participate in set up and clean up.
