

## Category-specific Rules

If you're unsure of which category to submit your art to, please email BERIBahamas@gmail.com. The FWWC Art team would be happy to help you.

### 2D & 3D Art Pieces

- 2D and 3D art pieces must be composed of recycled, non recyclable, salvaged or collected discarded materials.
- Submissions **must be created from individual collection / team collections / school assigned trash clean up.** The only purchased materials that can be used are glue, nails and other securing methods. 90% of the art piece must be collected debris or non recyclable materials. Submissions that use material purchased will not be eligible to win.
- If your art piece exceeds 10ft in height, length or depth you will need to notify (via email or on our social media messengers) the FWWC art team so we can make sure to accommodate your piece in the exhibit if chosen as a finalist.
- Artist(s) and their support team (Family / Friends / Guardians) are solely responsible for the transport of their piece to the awards ceremony.
- **Artist(s) are responsible for uploading a photo of their finished piece to the online registration form before Monday, JUNE 1st at 8pm.**

### Accompanying Literature

- Each submission must include a written component, which may take the form of an artist statement, short story, descriptive explanation, conservation message, or creative writing piece. The writing should describe the inspiration behind the artwork, the materials used, and/or the message the student or team hopes to share with the viewer. Submissions may be written in any format—such as poetry, a short story, or an essay—but must not exceed **500 words.**
