DOG POLICY

Please be advised that per The Woods at Great Creek Pets Policy Resolution, effective January 2005, *“No dogs of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept in dwelling unit at The Woods at Great Creek”*. Some unit owners are grandfathered in to have a dog under this policy, but **ONLY** those owners (or others with special permission granted from the Board). As a reminder, it is the responsibility of the owner to **CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!** Dogs **MUST** be on a leash while walking in common areas **AT ALL TIMES**. Fines will be imposed on the owner’s unit if these rules are not followed. Dogs that are aggressive will be required to be removed from the property, without delay.

CLEAN AIR ACT

Smoking in breezeways is **PROHIBITED** by the State of New Jersey. If you are caught smoking in the breezeways on our property, a fine will be assessed to your unit.

PARKING

Numbered spaces are reserved for the resident of that unit. Only unnumbered spaces are first come, first serve.

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON ROADWAYS.

NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES ALLOWED AFTER 8PM.

Vehicles **MUST** be kept in working condition. Any commercial vehicle parked overnight and abandoned vehicles will be tagged for towing.

FIRE PREVENTION

Please be extra careful when using grills. Any spark or hot ember can cause a fire when dry conditions or high winds occur. Grills must be stored and used away from the buildings at all times. **DO NOT** leave grills unattended. **FIRE PITS OF ANY KIND ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Anyone caught using a fire pit will be subject to fines. **FIREWORKS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON OUR PROPERTY.**

SAFETY TIPS

During warm weather, children will be outside more. Please be aware when you are driving. All children should be playing in designated playgrounds, fields, and paths. Any children riding bikes or scooters need to be aware of “the rules of the road,” just as any motor vehicle operator. Also be aware that there is a curfew on Association ground for children under 18 (unless accompanied by an adult), between 9:30PM and 6:00AM.

Car thefts are still running rampant in our area. Please be sure that your car is locked and your remote is not left in the car. **DO NOT** leave valuables in your car and in plain site.

RECYCLING

Please note the following information from Galloway Township regarding recycling: As of May 1, 2019, all electronic devices must be recycled at the 570 Galloway Road Convenience Center. The center is open on the 1st Saturday of each month between 8am and 2pm. Our trash company does not pick up any electronics. Regular recycling can be brought daily to the 2 dumpsters located in the office parking lot.

DROPBOX CHANGE

A new drop box has been installed in the clubhouse to ensure security of paperwork and payments that are left for management. The new slot is located on the wall to the right of the front door. The old drop slot in the door will be closed off starting on June 2nd.
