<i>Gifts</i>			
A	<i>Helping</i> The ability to assist and serve other people.	F	<i>Mercy</i> The ability to act out of compassion toward those who are suffering.
B	<i>Encouraging</i> The ability to support people and help them to regain hope.	G	<i>Hospitality</i> The gift of being friendly and generous to guests.
C	<i>Giving</i> The ability to give your time and money so that it can be used for God's work.	H	<i>Leading</i> The ability to motivate others to use their spiritual gifts and to do their best for the work of the Lord.
D	<i>Teaching</i> The ability to teach the Bible in such a way that people learn and grow.	I	<i>Evangelism</i> The ability to help others to come to know Jesus personally.
E	<i>Pastoring</i> The ability to effectively guide and care for people in their walk with God.	J	<i>Faith</i> The ability to have a confident belief that God will always do what is the very best.
