Award Possession


- “Red Ball”

Red Ball!




Simultaneous – Awarding the Ball




Less Total Foul Time

Dead Ball Fouls Tree





Communication, Communication, Communication

Official's Challenge

- A1 slashes B1, flag down. B2 then slashes A2, stopping play
- What is the ruling?
 - Simultaneous Fouls. B2 and A1 each serve a non-releasable penalty
- Who gets the ball and where?
 - Team B is awarded the ball where it was when the whistle was blown

Official's Challenge

- During a live ball B1 cross-checks A1, flag down
- B2 then slashes A1, second flag down
- A2 slashes B2, stopping play
- What is the ruling?
 - Simultaneous fouls. B1, B2, and A2 all serve non-releasable penalties
- Who gets the ball and where?
 - Team A is awarded the ball where the ball was when the whistle was blown

Official's Challenge

- While the ball is loose, B1 pushes A1, play on. A2 goes offside.
- What is the ruling?
 - Whistle is blown when A2 goes offside
 - No penalty time is served
- Who gets the ball and where?
 - Team A at the spot the ball was when the whistle was blown

Official's Challenge

- After the whistle blows suspending play with Team A entitled to possession:
 - B1 slashes A1
 - A1 retaliates and slashes B1
- What is the ruling?
 - B1 and A1 each serve non-releasable penalties
- Who gets the ball and where?
 - Team B one step over the midline on their offensive half

Official's Challenge

- Clock stopped with Team A entitled to possession in their defensive half:
 - B1 argues with the official, conduct foul is called and Team A awarded possession at Center X
 - Team A delays the game
- What is the ruling?
 - Turnover. No penalty time is served
- Who gets the ball and where?
 - Team B at midfield

Official's Challenge

- B1 pushes A1 with possession during a live ball. Flag down
- After play is stopped A1 delays the game
- What is the ruling?
 - Not simultaneous
 - Live-ball push
 - Dead-ball delay of game
 - B1 serves 30-second penalty. A1 serves no time
- Who gets the ball and where?
 - Team B at the spot
 - A1 is not serving time. By rule, Team B is awarded possession where the ball was when play ended
