Your presence at TDT provides additional adult supervision on the dance floor with the teens. Your presence also balances the ratio of girls and guys. Your regular attendance and commitment are extremely important. We depend on you in many ways. If you register to be a DAD, we expect you to be present.

The need for DADs is based on the number of teens registered and the ratio of girls and guys. If you are interested, please complete the form below and mail it as soon as possible along with your teen's registration form. Make sure you indicate whether your attendance will be on Fridays or at TDT Lite, respectively.
