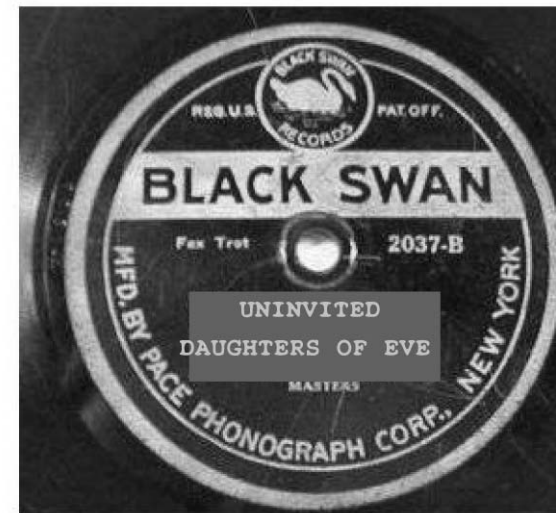
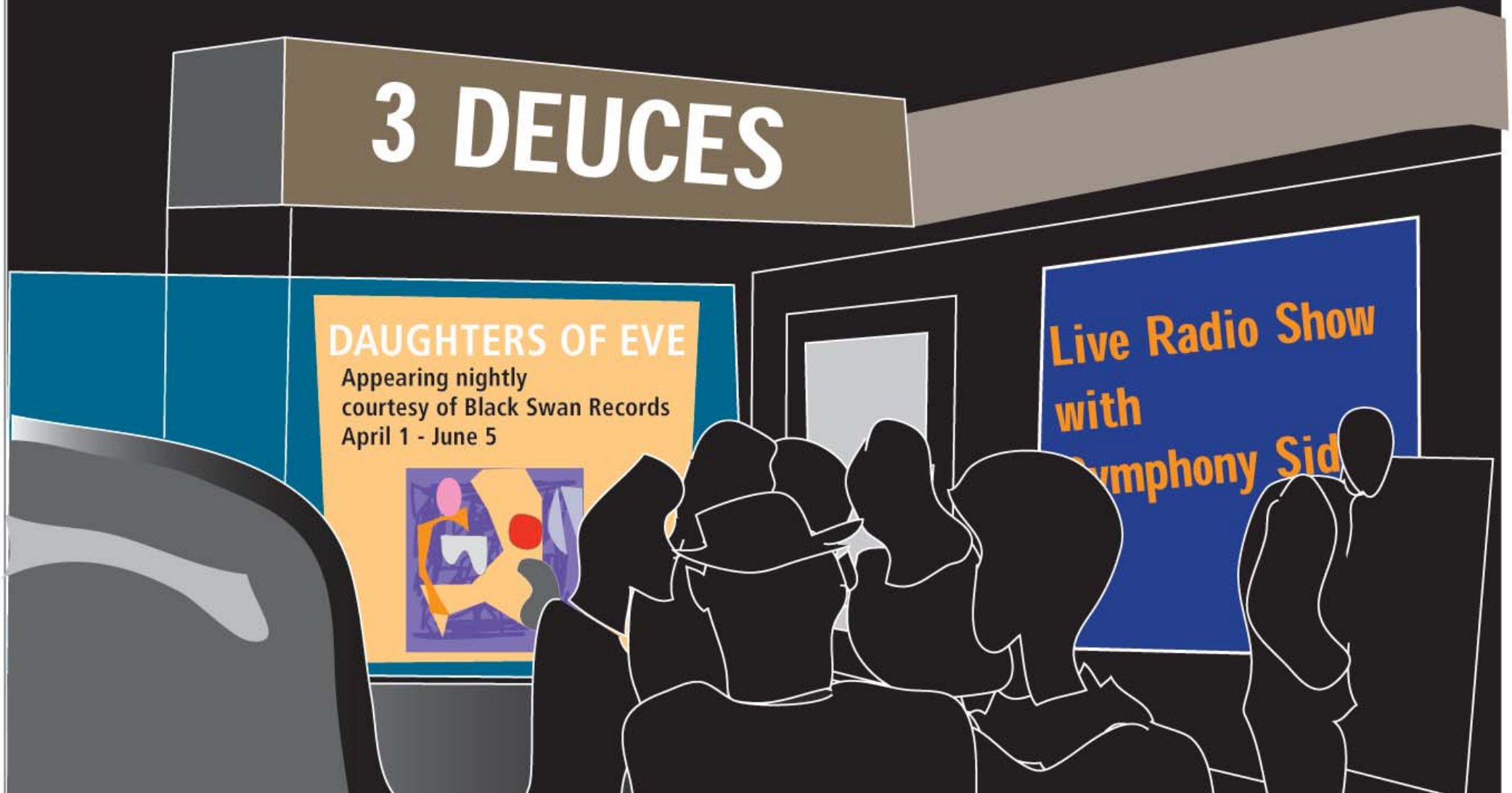

Daughters of Eve



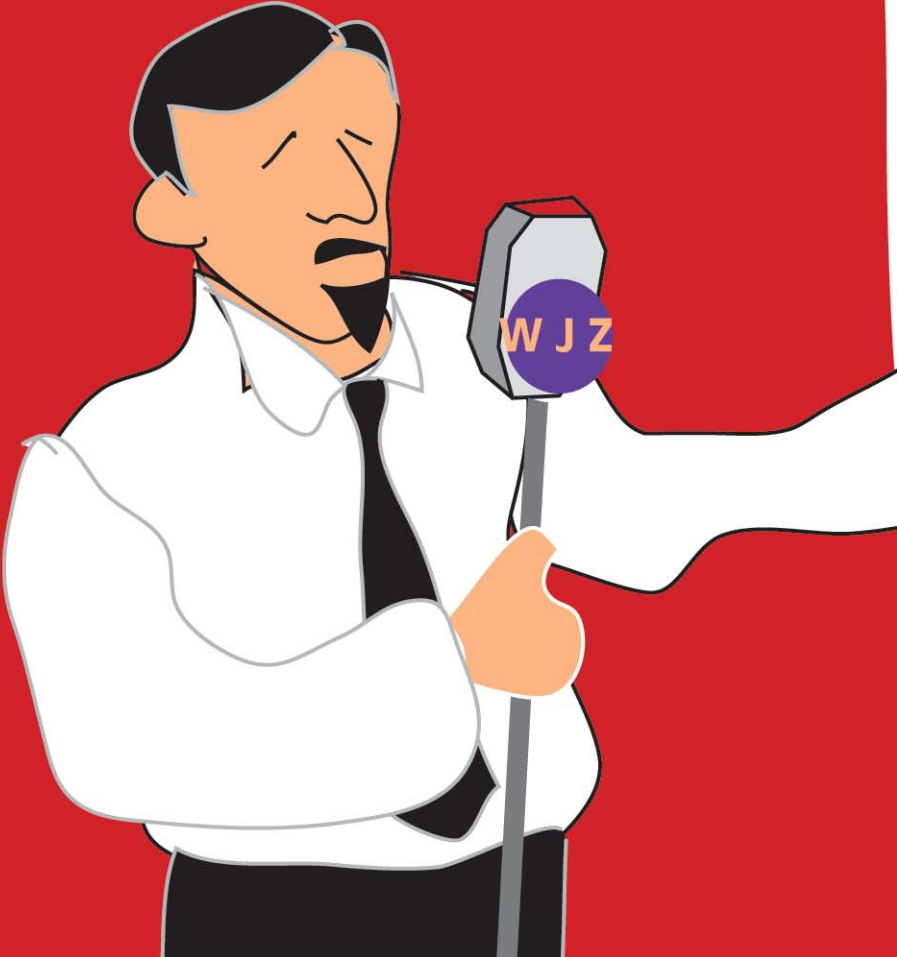
The Daughters of Eve made their debut at a Greenwich Village jazz club in March 1952.

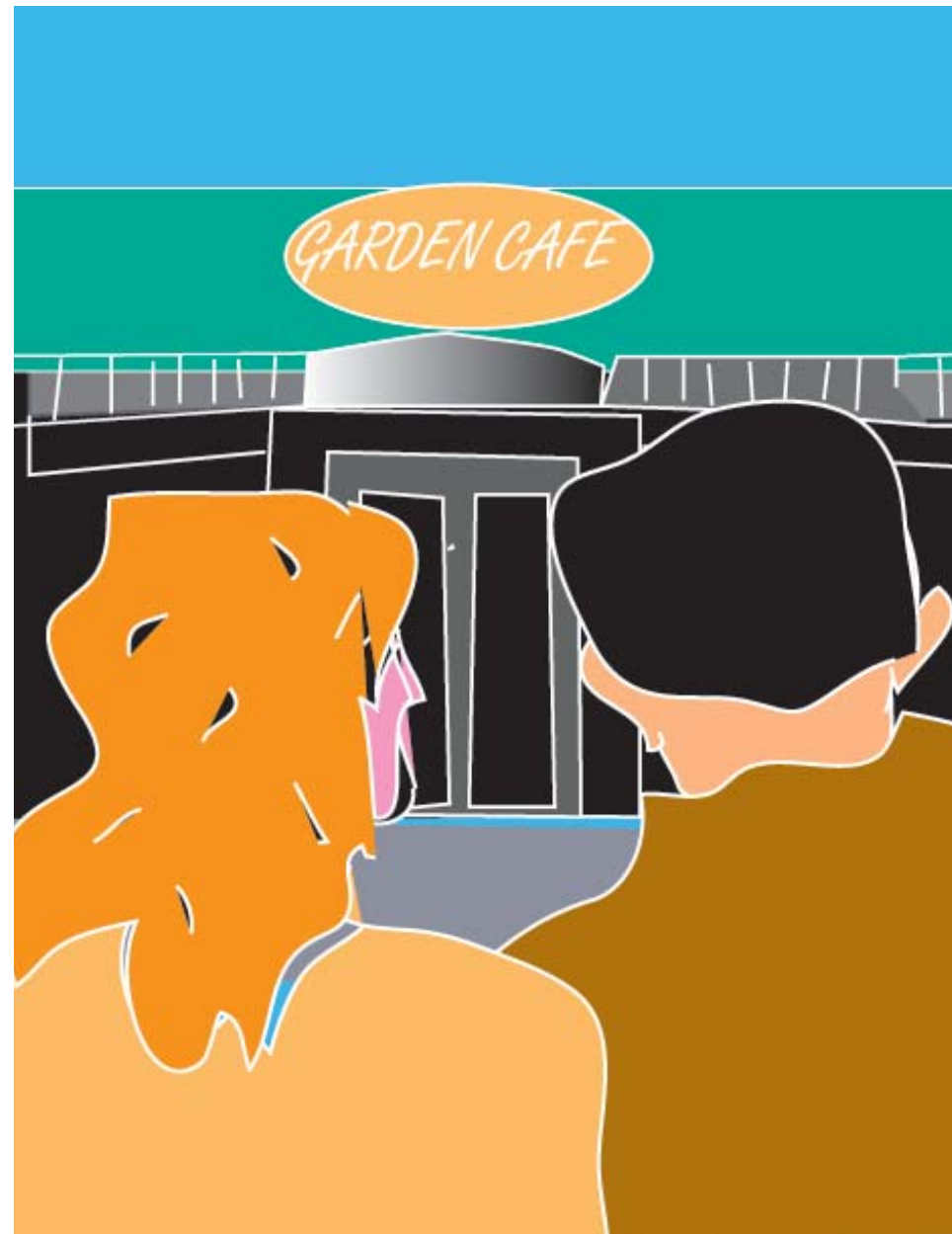
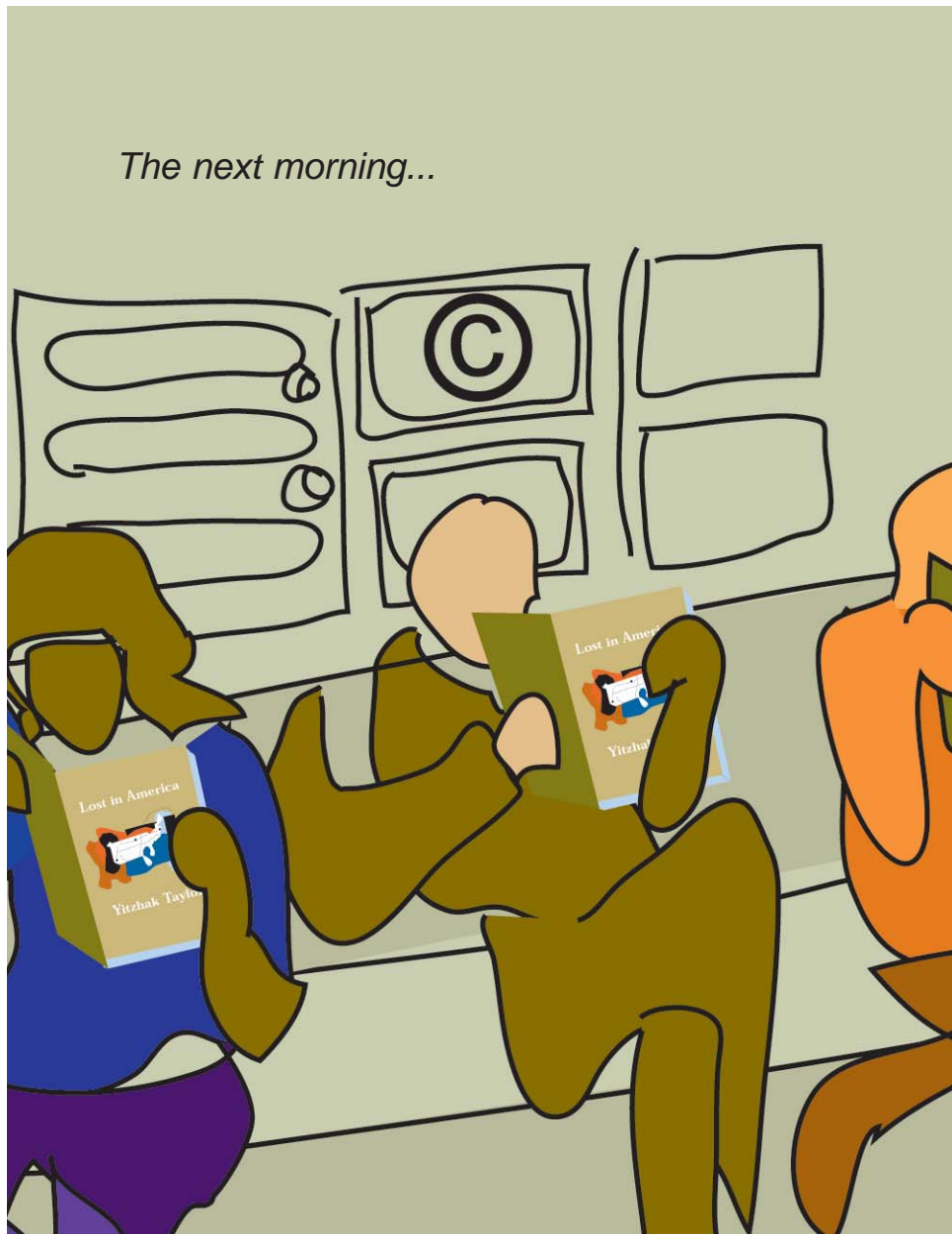


I'm so proud of her. The jazz world is just as tightly shuttered to women as the classical world. But she did it.

New York in 1933.

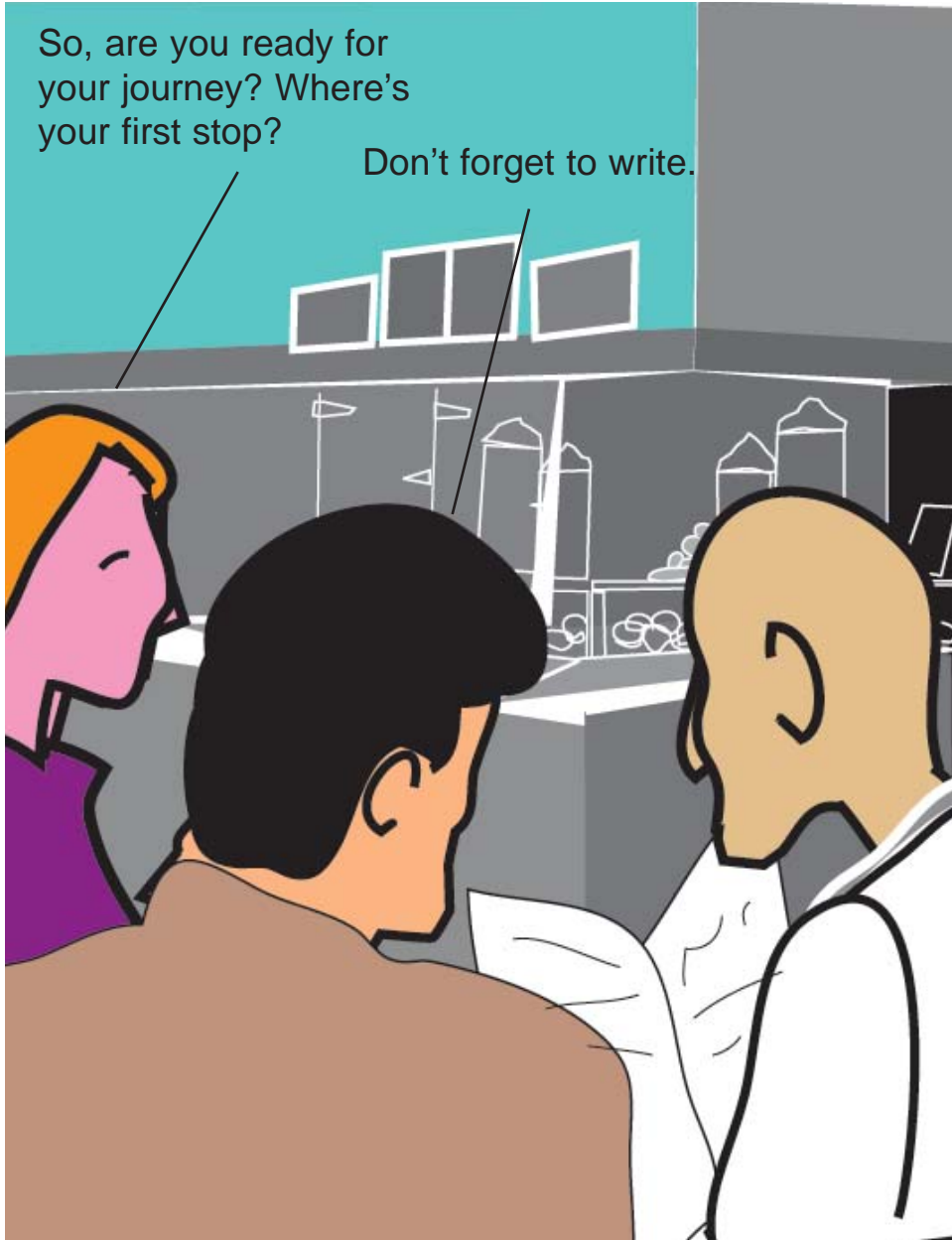
His column, *The Magical Realist* appears biweekly in Yiddish and English in *The Jewish Daily Forward*.
