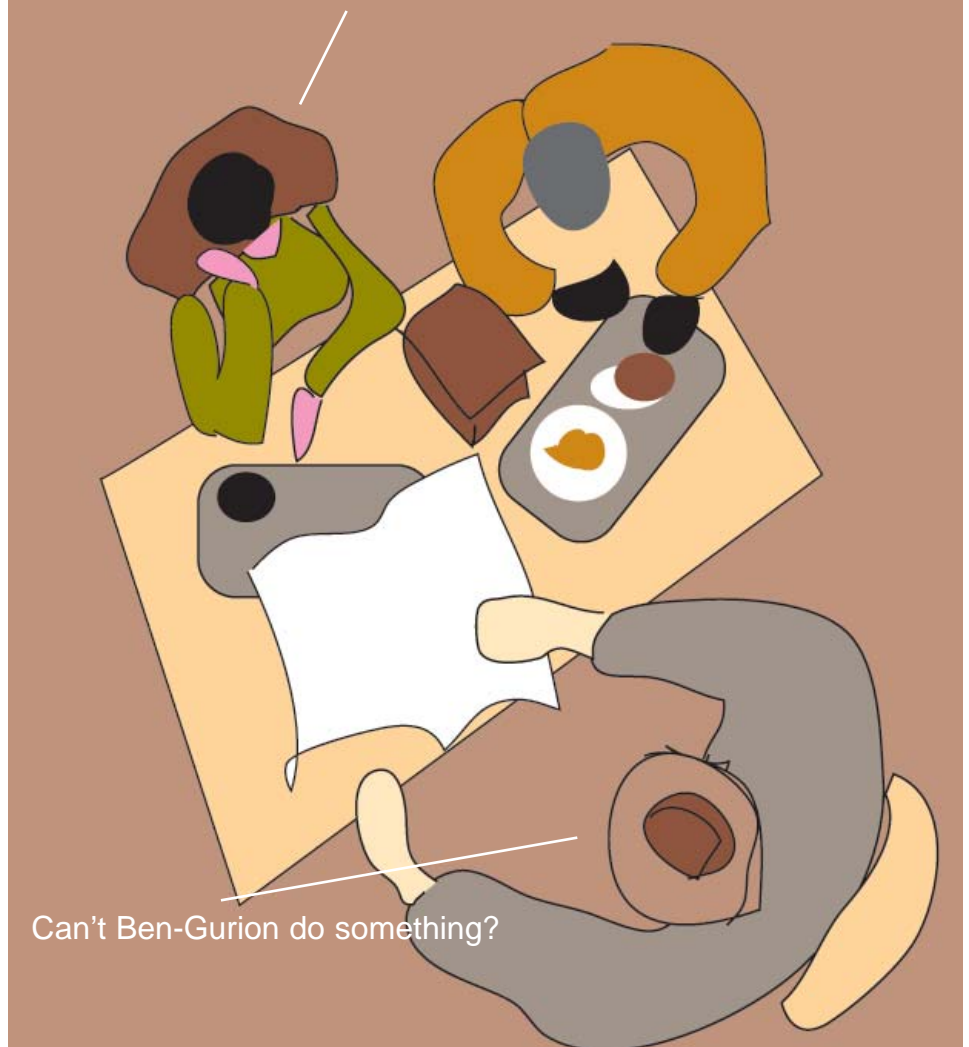






Zionist table:
