

REMOTE MONITORING



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Currently, Independent and Assisted Living facilities are limited by law on how much monitoring they can do for their residents. During this time of heightened COVID-19 concern, this is especially difficult for family members who cannot visit their loved ones and want to make sure they

are getting the oversight they need to maintain or regain their health.

As well, according to medical experts who have been treating COVID-19, monitoring can be essential to early detection and treatment (see below).

For these reasons, Clear Guidance is now offering Remote Monitoring by an RN Care Manager. All monitoring is done via video conferencing that can be installed and set up in coordination with the facility. Equipment and set up fee is nominal and services are on an as needed basis.

Services include:

- Vital sign monitoring (temperature, pulse, O2 level and blood pressure)
- Symptom overview/reporting
- Coordination with PCP
- Coordination with facility
- Emergency response

In his recent article in the New York Times, Dr. Richard Levitan, an Emergency Doctor at Bellevue Hospital insists close monitoring can detect "silent hypoxia", a precursor to Covid pneumonia. According to Dr. Levitan, early detection and treatment are the key to successful recovery.
