My wife and I, as well as others we have talked to, have recently been experiencing some phone issues with full service for a couple minutes and then no service, cutting off phone conversations. I've tried calling the person back and it says, "failed call". A few minutes later it will be back to full service again. Unreliable is the word I would use, and it usually happens when I am home.

Don't we all desire reliability? Whether it's our vehicles we drive, our phones we use, or our friends we have, we want reliability. None of these arenas can promise us 100% of the time that they will work or be there for

us. But there is one who is beyond reliable. He is totally trustworthy and always has our best interest in mind. You know who it is – God!

We can put all our eggs in that basket (even though they are expensive - Ha! Ha!). The Word of God tells us to build our lives around this one who is trustworthy. There is a text many of us grew up with that informs us as to how we learn to trust Him. We build our lives on His Word and in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ our Savior. Here is the text from Matthew 7:24ff

"Therefore, everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the wind blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."

A house built on sand is unreliable. It won't hold up when the storms come. A house built on the Rock (Jesus Christ) will always stand firm. You can count on the foundation laid in Jesus Christ. He will always be there for you!

It is good to have a constant in our lives that we can always count on and Jesus is it. God is on the throne. The Holy Spirit has taken residence in our hearts. Build on that by reading and digesting his Word and you will not be disappointed.
