Memorial Day Service 10 am Monday May 29th

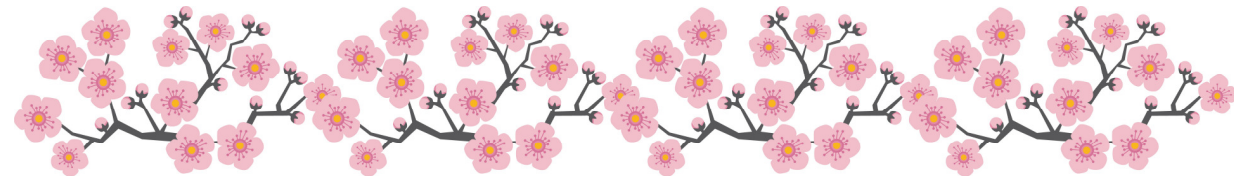

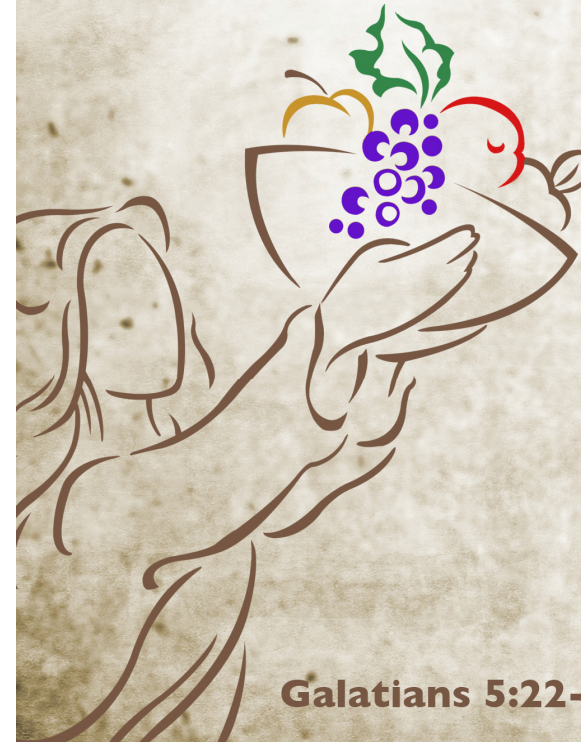
