Mike's Musings

We have been studying the book of Romans on Wednesdays and I thought I'd share a little of what we have been learning. We spent about four weeks going over this chapter, but this section gave me the hardest time.

Romans 12:14-21 "Bless those

who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion. Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

"Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse." This is imposable. I have to realize I can't do this in the flesh. I need Jesus to help. Then Paul tells us, "Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. Be of the same mind toward one another." Paul tells us we all need to fellowship with likeminded believers and to share in their joys and sorrows.

Paul goes on to tell us we need to be humble and not think too much of ourselves. "Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion." This too is challenging. We are not being teachable if we think we know it all. God wants the best for us and helps us with His words of instructions like this: "Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

I'll end with this thought, if we love our enemy, they will no longer be an enemy they will be our friend. None of this is possible to do without God, if you don't know Him, seek Him out. I know He has changed me. Let God make you new.

Please help Church of the Straits and Samaritan's Purse teach needy children around the world the true meaning of Christmas and give them a Christmas they will remember for a lifetime:


- 1. Take a box, pick an age
