Mike's Musings

The adult Sunday school class has been studying the 23rd Psalm and we have been learning how God does things in our life to show us He is there going through whatever the trial that we are experiencing. The part that the study is focusing on is in

Psalms 23:5 "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies." So, what does that mean? When I think of what this looks like I see a scene with a battle going on. A table comes down before me and my favorite food is laid out across the table, and there on the other side of the table sits Jesus. He asks me to sit down and take a rest with Him. Right there in the middle of my battle. Then God says to my enemies, "This is my child. They are with me at my table."

Jesus can do this for you too. When troubles come into our lives, we should go straight to God with what is going on. He doesn't want us to carry it alone. Sometimes we are under attack from the evil one. Scriptures tell us in 1 Peter 5:8 Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. So, when your battle is raging and all seems lost. Look for God to bring down a table and have a feast with the Lord God Himself. He wants to be there for you. Now go ahead and believe it and take a rest.

Remember God is good all the time, and all the time God is good.
