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Individual should be tested for COVID-19
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Two of the following: fever (measured or subjective), chills, fatigue, myalgia, headache, sore throat, congestion or running nose, nausea, If test result is **negative** OR doctor's note with differential diagnosis, return to school after 24 hours afebrile **and** resolving . vomiting, or diarrhea respiratory symptoms OR If test result is **positive** or individual is unable/refuses to get tested, follow guidance for isolation for Covid-19 ٠ One of the following: cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, or new loss of taste or smell (click here for full CDC list) **Isolation Requirements for Covid-19** Per Montgomery County Public Health Code, pertaining to the reporting, isolation, quarantine, and respective disease control measures (including contact tracing) for the control of communicable diseases. WITH SYMPTOMS WITHOUT SYMPTOMS May return to school after: May return to school after: Positive COVID-19 PCR or 5 days after specimen was collected • 24 hours with no fever AND **Antigen (Point of Care) Test** Masks worn around others days 6-10 • Resolving symptoms **AND** If symptoms develop during the 5 days, follow return to school guidance for positive PCR or Antigen test • 5 days since symptoms first appeared WITH symptoms Masks worn around others days 6-10 **Quarantine Requirements for Covid-19** Per Montgomery County Public Health Code, pertaining to the reporting, isolation, quarantine, and respective disease control measures (including contact tracing) for the control of communicable diseases. **Close Contact to Positive** WITH SYMPTOMS WITHOUT SYMPTOMS **COVID VACCINATION EXCEPTION** Individuals should be tested for • Quarantine for 5 days after last exposure Within 6ft for 15 minutes or more People do **NOT** need to quarantine after an exposure if they meet ONE of the following criteria: COVID-19 and isolate until results • Testing is recommended on day 5 exposure • Age 18 or older and have received all recommended vaccine doses, including boosters if Household contact are known • Masks worn around others days eligible, and additional primary shots for some immunocompromised people* 6-10 • Age 5-17 years and completed the primary series of COVID-19 vaccines* Exception: In the K-12 indoor classroom setting or a Household contacts may require further structured outdoor setting where mask use can be AND remain asymptomatic since last exposed investigation, but are to follow the above guidance. observed, **Positive** test result Recommended to get a test on day 5 after last exposure the close contact definition excludes students who were Refer to isolation Everyone should monitor symptoms for 10 days. Refer to isolation requirements • Follow sick policy • Wear a mask in around others for 10 days after exposure
