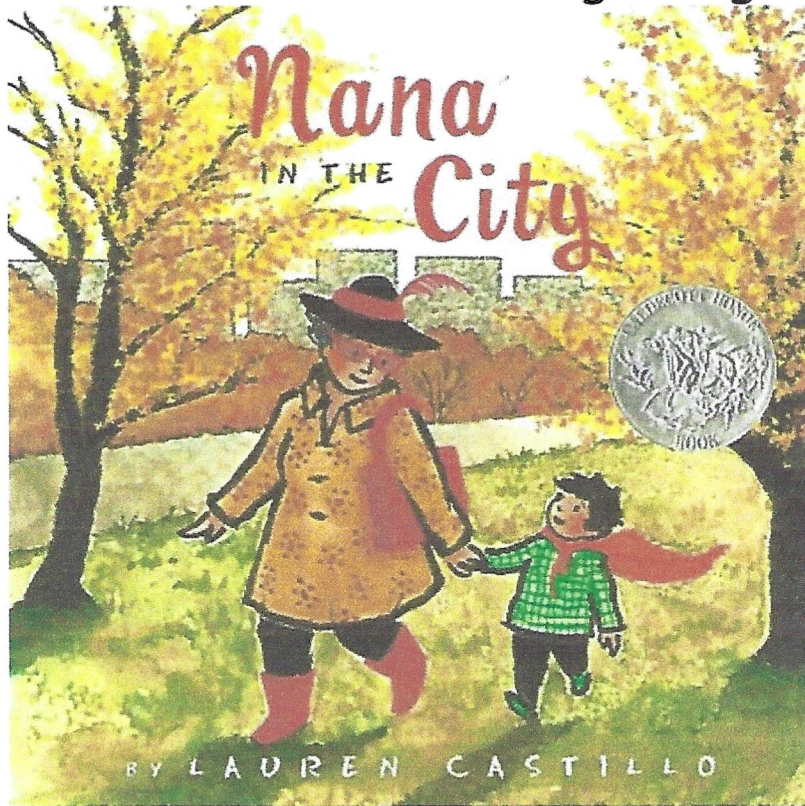


First Grade Summer Reading Assignment
